## New rates for the September garbage bill

The current garbage contract will expire on August 31, 2005. We advertised and received bids from Waste Management and York Waste. The borough will be remaining with York Waste as they were the lower bidder. The garbage bid had a 36%

increase. Therefore, the Borough Council acted to raise the garbage rates. Please find below the old rates and what the new rate will be effective with the 9/1/05 billing. The residential rate will increase from \$36.19 to \$50.00 a quarter. All non-residential rates will

be increased as well. Please feel free to contact the borough office for your new non-residential rate.

Remember all payments are to be made at the First National Bank of Marysville.

## 2005 SWIM LESSONS



- No refunds will be given after the second lesson.




Fees are as follows: First Child - \$50.00. Second & Third Child - \$45.00 each, Four or more - \$40.00 each.

## *Police News*

THE SIGNS ARE HERE.....We have just received a shipment of SLOW DOWN Yard Signs. If you are interested in having one displayed in your yard, please stop by the borough office and pick one up. One states SLOW DOWN and the second states SLOW DOWN, CHILDREN AT PLAY. There is no cost for the signs. Supplies are limited so act fast.

Parents, Parents, Parents.....please be aware there are two ordinances on the borough books concerning curfew and skateboarding in the Borough of Marysville. Following is an outline of these ordinances.

**CURFEW**—Parents, There is a misconception that we need to actually physically catch your child after curfew in order for you, the parent, to be fined. Wrong! An officer merely needs to see a juvenile and be able to identify that he/she is in fact the child of the parent being fined. You may feel curfew is an insignificant violation. The majority of criminal mischief violations, i.e. damage of property, are perpetrated by juveniles out after curfew. It should be of no great surprise that the parents of the violators permit their child to go out after curfew with the bogus warning “Just don’t get caught”. Most kids are monitored by their parents and obey the curfew ordinance. Ordinance 346 Curfew hours are as follows: Under the age of 14 is 10:00 PM until 6:00 AM and Ages 14 - 18 is 11:00 PM - 6:00 AM

**SKATEBOARDING** - Borough Ordinance 410, section 101 states that Skateboarding, Scootering and sledding are PROHIBITED and is restricted on Sidewalks, Streets and Alleys.....No person or persons shall coast or ride upon any sled, scooter, skateboard, three-wheeled, pedaled conveyance **without brakes** or similar conveyance upon any street or alley in the Borough of Marysville.

## Wesley United Methodist Church Events




