Leaf collection will begin in November



The Borough's leaf collection will start in November.

Make sure you watch for our **FLUORESCENT GREEN NO PARKING SIGNS.**


Signs will be posted on each street to notify residents when the leaf

collection will take place in your area.

Leaf collection guidelines are as follows:

- Leaf collection will begin on November 1st (weather permitting) and end in early December. If you have leaves after leaf collection has been completed, it will be your responsibility to dispose of the leaves. **THERE WILL BE NO SPECIAL PICKUPS.**
- Where possible without blocking lanes, place leaves on street pavement. Where curbs are present, keep a foot of pavement cleared between curb and leaf piles.

- Be sure that only leaves are in the piles. Sticks, rocks, pieces of wood and other debris can cause serious damage to the collection equipment and delay the schedule.




Old man winter is just around the corner



Ordinance 227 - Responsibility for Removal of Snow and Ice; Time Limit. The owner, occupant or tenant of every property fronting or abutting upon or alongside of any of the streets in the Borough of Marysville is hereby required to remove or cause to be removed from all sidewalks in front of or alongside of or directly to the rear of such property all snow and ice thereon fallen or formed within twenty-four hours after the same shall have ceased to fall or to be formed. Provided: the owner of a property shall be responsible for conforming to the requirements of this section where such property is unoccupied or vacant or is a multiple-dwelling property, occupied by more than one tenant or occupier; the tenant or occupant of a property shall be responsible therefore in case of a single-unit property occupied by such owner or tenant.





- All smoke alarms must have a battery backup if hard wired.

Make sure your heating system is working properly and your chimney is clear. You should have your heating system checked at least once a year.
