The Borough has received notification that the Pennsylvania State Transportation Committee officially selected Marysville's Downtown Commercial Business District Streetscape project for funding. As soon as all the contracts are signed and the funding is in place we will begin enhancements to the square area. Part of our goal is to support our existing businesses as well as attract newcomers to the area.

Another revitalization project is underway *under* Kings Highway. The Borough received Community Revitalization funding from Senator Corman for a portion of the project. Additional funds will be forthcoming from the Community Development Block Grant program. A portion of the sewer line needs replaced and other portions need rehabilitated. We will appreciate your understanding while these improvement projects are under construction.


