The Borough is pleased to announce the approval of two grants. DCNR has approved funding to replace the kiddie wading pool. PennDOT has approved a grant application for the Marysville Downtown Commercial Business District Streetscape. This will be a huge undertaking and we will advise the public well before the work will begin. We will be hosting a public meeting after the selection of the firm chosen to oversee the site design. Three other state agencies have been drawn into this project which we anticipate will include Heritage Park improvements.

Leaf collection will begin in November

The Borough's leaf collection will start in November.

Signs will be posted on each street to notify residents when the leaf collection will take place in your area.



Leaf collection guidelines are as follows:

- Leaf collection will begin on November 1st (weather permitting) and end in early December. If you have leaves after leaf collection has been completed, it will be your responsibility to dispose of the leaves.
- **THERE WILL BE NO SPECIAL PICKUPS.**
- Where possible without blocking lanes, place leaves on street pavement. Where curbs are present, keep a foot of pavement cleared between curb and leaf piles.
- Be sure that only leaves are in the piles. Sticks, rocks, pieces of wood and other debris can cause serious damage to the collection equipment and delay the schedule.




