Sewer Problems? Please call the Borough Office

If any borough resident has a sewer related problem, please contact the Marysville Borough office at 957-3110 during normal working hours [8:00am-4:00pm] or after hours contact 648-3820 for emergencies. We can determine if the problem is in your lateral or in the main prior to you contacting a plumber. In certain cases, the cause of the problem may be related to the sewer main which is the borough's responsibility to maintain. In other cases, the responsibility will fall on the homeowner if the problem is located in the lateral that connects to the sewer main. By consulting with the borough first, we can determine if the problem merits contacting a plumber or if it is a problem that the borough can remedy.



MARYSVILLE BOROUGH POOL INFORMATION SHEET

MEMBERSHIP RULES

- ◆ Family Memberships are limited to use by members of an individual's immediate family which are:
 - * spouses, live in companions, children or step children
 - * under the age of 18 living in the same household
 - * an individual's grandchild who are living with the individual for the summer may be included
 - * grandparents who watch a grandchild(ren)
you may be asked to provide proof of residency or identification
- ◆ Other relatives living with the family (ex. brothers, sisters, aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, etc.) must purchase their own membership.
- ◆ Memberships are *NON-TRANSFERABLE*. Anyone letting others use their cards will face automatic loss of membership. No refund will be given.
- ◆ A \$5.00 replacement fee will be charged for lost cards.
- ◆ Membership cards *MUST BE SHOWN TO GAIN ADMITTANCE TO THE POOL* or the daily admission fee will be charged.

CLOSING POLICY

We reserve the right to close the pool for the following reasons:

- * Inclement Weather (rain, storms, cold temperatures)
- * Low attendance (less than 10 people in the water)
- * Emergency Situations
- * Lack of availability of lifeguards
- * Pre-scheduled events

POOL HOURS

Public Swim: Monday through Friday 12:00noon - 7:00pm, Saturday and Sunday 12:00noon - 6:00pm

Private Pool Party/Rental: Fridays , 7:00pm - 9:00pm and Saturday, 6:00pm - 8:00pm

The pool will not be open for Memorial Day Weekend or Labor Day Weekend this year.

POOL RENTALS

Day Birthday Party - If your child wants to have a birthday party, why not have a pool party. Your party will include a lunch consisting of a hot dog, chips, drink and popsicle.

Rates: 10 people - \$85.00 each additional person \$8.00

Evening Party - The pool can be rented on Friday (7:00 - 9:00pm) or Saturday (6:00 - 8:00pm) evening. The rental price is \$175.00, which includes the lifeguard staff, pool usage and pool lights. A non-refundable deposit of \$75.00 is required in advance.

DAILY PASSES

Ages 5 - 18 \$5.00 Ages over 18 - \$6.00

NEW THIS YEAR - 10 day pass - Child (\$40.00) Adult (\$50.00)

Marysville Borough Pool Rules and Regulations

- * All persons who enter the pool do so at their own risk. We are not responsible for any accident, injury, theft or damage to personal property.
- * Smoking and alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
- * Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a person of 16 or older who will accept responsibility for the safety and conduct of the child. Individuals found irresponsible will be asked to leave the pool.
- * No running, pushing, spitting, rough housing, profanity, or lewd behavior permitted.
- * No glass containers, metal or bulky items are permitted in the pool area.
- * Adult Swims: adults may take their children 6 and younger, into the shallow end. The deep end of the pool is for adults 18 years and older. The adult swims are at the discretion of the lifeguards.
- * Lifeguards may refuse a swimmer admission to any pool area if the swimmer does not exhibit sufficient skill to insure his/her safety.
- * In case of an accident, report it immediately to a lifeguard of the Pool Manager.
- * Management reserves the right to refuse admission to anyone with skin abrasions, colds, coughs, inflamed eyes, athlete's feet, infectious disorders, communicable diseases, or persons wearing band-aids.
- * The cost of any property damage shall be charged to the responsible member, including damage caused by the guest of the member.
- * Any member allowing another person to use his/her pool pass may result in suspension of pool privileges.
- * Thongs are prohibited
- * All swimmers must wear a bathing suit or bathing trunks.
- * Showers are required before swimming.

WADING/BABY POOL

- * The wading/baby pool is not under the immediate supervision of a lifeguard. Parents and/or Guardians are reminded that children in the wading/baby pool are ***THEIR*** responsibility.
- * Children in diapers are required to wear swim diapers.
- * The wading/baby pool is for children under the age of 6.

SLIDES

- * No horseplay, pushing, running or cutting in line.
- * You must slide and enter the pool feet first.
- * Clear the landing area or exit the pool by the ladder.
- * One slider at a time—no stopping.

Any objectionable activities or items not covered in the above rules and regulations will be judged by the Pool Manager.


The Pool Manager and/or any other personnel are the absolute authority and may discipline, suspend or dismiss any pool member or guest who violates pool rules. Serious or successive violations may be sufficient cause for cancellation of membership with no refund.

PARENTS: Instruct your children and urge them to read and observe all rules and to obey the Pool Manager, lifeguards and other employees.

LIFEGUARDS NEEDED

We are seeking individuals to fill lifeguard positions for the 2007 season.

Minimum age requirement for lifeguard is 16 years of age.



The Commonwealth of PA requires life saving and CPR skills and certification that you successfully completed the Lifeguard course.

If you successfully complete the training courses and are employed by the borough through the end of the pool season, your training fees will be reimbursed to you.



NOTICE TO PET OWNERS




With spring and summer approaching we would like to remind pet owners the law requires pets to be kept on a leash and pet waste be cleaned up and disposed of properly.

Sewer and garbage billing tips

1. Remember the new due dates. Bills are generated four times a year (March 1st, June 1st, September 1st, and December 1st).
2. All bills are due within 30 days of the date of billing. Payments received after the 30 days will be assessed a 1.5% penalty for every 30 days they go unpaid.
3. If you are unable to manage your payments, contact the Borough Office to be placed on a payment arrangement.
4. Payments should be made at the First National Bank of Marysville. Only payments on accounts that are on a payment arrangement should be made at the Borough Office.
5. Any questions you may have regarding your account should be directed to the Borough Office, not the bank.
6. When making payments at the bank, please keep in mind that the business day ends at 2:00 p.m. Any payments made after 2:00 p.m. will be credited to the account on the following business day.
7. When a unit becomes vacant, the Borough Office must be notified in writing by filing an Occupancy/Vacancy report in order for the owner to receive the vacant billing rates. When it becomes reoccupied, it will be necessary to file the report again noting the new occupants' name.
8. If you make a payment without including your billing stub, please note your account number for processing purposes.
