## Leaf collection will begin in November

Signs will be posted on each street to notify residents when the leaf collection will take place in your area.

Leaf collection guidelines are as follows:

- Leaf collection will begin the last week of October (weather permitting) and end in mid-November. If you have leaves after leaf collection has been completed, it will be your responsibility to dispose of the leaves.
- **THERE WILL BE NO SPECIAL PICKUPS.**
- Where possible, without blocking lanes, place leaves on street pavement. Where curbs are present, keep a foot of pavement cleared between curb and leaf piles.
- Be sure that only leaves are in the piles. Sticks, rocks, pieces of wood and other debris can cause serious damage to the collection equipment and delay the schedule.



**Warning!** Please be advised that the Borough of Marysville's liability insurance may or may not cover claims dealing with water damaged basements due to sewer main clogs or sewer main breaks. It is highly recommended for all home owners to contact their insurance company for additional insurance to cover water and sewer claims.

**Trash Pickup!** The Borough of Marysville has recently contracted with Interstate Waste Services for the collection of refuse and recycling. Please be advised that collection begins at 5:00am on Fridays and all residents are encouraged to have their trash curbside by that time. Any trash bags that are not out by 5:00am will not be picked up until the following week. The four-bag limit is still in place and residents are to contact Interstate Waste Services at 800-223-3888 for large item pickup.

**Puzzled about what to do with left over oil based paint and paint products, automotive fluids, pool chemicals, batteries, degreasers, solvents, pesticides and toxic household cleaners in your home and garage?**

## **1.) Call the HHW Hotline 1-800-449-7587 (1-800-HHW-PKUP) to request a collection:**

The operator will fully explain the program and ask a few questions that will include the type and amount of material you have for collection and your address. A collection appointment will be arranged at this time.



## **2.) Assemble your Collection Kit:**

Your HHW collection kit should arrive via UPS within a few days. Assemble all of your HHW according to the instructions provided in the kit. Use provided labels to ensure materials are clearly marked. Materials without lids or those that are leaking will not be accepted. The kit can hold up to 75 pounds of HHW securely.

## **3.) Place your Collection Kit out for Pick-Up:**

Place the kit near your garage or porch by 8:00 AM on your prearranged collection date. A Customer Service Representative from Curbside, Inc will stop by to pick up your collection kit. Participants will receive a postage-paid survey card to be completed and mailed to the Perry Conservation District to help track the program. That's it! You do not even need to be home.



**Perry County residents can call today for a home pick-up of household hazardous waste (HHW). Collections are limited to one per household, and will cost a small fee of \$15.00 payable to Curbside, Inc.**

This summer Boy Scout Troop 56 of Marysville travelled to The Northern Tier Donald Rogert Canoe Base, a National High Adventure Base, in Atikokan, Ontario. There were 19 members of Troop 56 and three members of Troop 94 Shermansdale who participated in 65 miles of canoeing on the Hudson Bay Company's historic fur route between Old Fort William and Rainy Lake. This remote canoeing experience took place within the Turtle River-White Otter Provincial Park, a part of the Crown Lands. The participants were able to observe millions of acres of pine forests, glacier lakes, meandering rivers and thundering waterfalls. They also observed wildlife, caught walleye, northern lake trout and smallmouth bass, and visited Indian Pictographs.

The Northern Tier High Adventure Program is the oldest continuously operating high adventure program in the Boy Scouts of America, and has been delivering wilderness canoeing adventure during the summer, along with its cold weather program Okpik, in the winter. The Donald Rogert Canoe Base is located 13 miles west of Atikokan, Ontario on Perch Lake.

Troop 56 is currently planning to attend the 100th anniversary celebration of the Boy Scouts of America at the 2010 National Jamboree at Fort A.P. Hill in Virginia. Boys age 11 through 17 are encouraged to join Troop 56. The Troop meets every Wednesday, 7:00 P.M. at the Marysville Lions Club.
