Snow and Ice Removal Reminders

Responsibility for Removal of Snow and Ice; Time Limit.

The owner, occupant or tenant of every property fronting or abutting upon or alongside of any the streets in the Borough of Marysville is hereby required to remove or cause to be removed from all sidewalks in front of or alongside of or directly to the rear of such property all snow and ice thereon fallen or formed within twenty-four hours after the same shall have ceased to fall or to be formed. Provided: the owner of a property shall be responsible for conforming to the requirements of this section where such property is unoccupied or vacant or is a multiple-dwelling property, occupied by

more than one tenant or occupier; the tenant or occupant of a property shall be responsible therefore in case of a single-unit property occupied by such owner or tenant.



Removing of Snow from Sidewalks

It is unlawful to place snow from sidewalks or private property onto the street. Deposit of snow removed to facilitate parking: It shall be a violation of this ordinance for anyone to, in anyway, throw, discharge or place snow from the sidewalk or private property onto the borough streets. Snow which is removed from the street to provide space for parked cars must be deposited adjacent to curbing and not placed on the roadbed on which traffic travels.

2009 Municipal Elections

The Pennsylvania Municipal Primary is on Tuesday, May 19, 2009. Individuals wishing to run for election can begin circulating and filing nominations petitions February 17th and the last day to register before the primary is April 20th. The Municipal Election is Tuesday, November 3rd.

Council members serve four year terms and can serve on the Finance Committee, Sewer and Sanitation Committee or the Streets Committee. The term will begin January 1, 2010 and expire December 31, 2013.

The Marysville Borough Tax Collector serves a four year term

which will run from January 1, 2010 to December 31, 2013.

The Mayor serves a four year term from January 1, 2010 to December 31, 2013.


