## The Manager's Corner

The Borough of Marysville started 2009 by approving annual budgets for the general fund, sewer fund, pool fund and state highway aid fund. In total, the 2009 budget for all funds was \$1,842,335.00. With the New Year came new regulations pertaining to open records. Governor Rendell signed the Right-To-Know Law, which took effect January 1<sup>st</sup> and requires municipalities to provide individuals of the commonwealth certain documents if requested. In accordance with the new law, the borough appointed an Open Record's Officer and document request forms can be picked up at the borough office.

Projects to be completed this fiscal year include the Wading Pool Replacement Project, Trout Run Project, Square Sanitary Sewer Separation, and Kings Highway Paving Project. The Wading Pool Replacement Project was awarded to Vision Pools in 2008 with the assistance of a grant from the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources. The new wading pool is anticipated to be ready for the upcoming pool season and will be a zero entry pool that is handicap accessible. Bids were received for the Trout Run Stabilization and Sewer Main Replacement Project on January 29<sup>th</sup>. The project includes bank stabilization in front of Little Mountain Estates and replaces 320 feet of 8" sanitary sewer main on Kings Highway. The bid was awarded to DeTraglia Construction in the amount of \$54,356.00 and is scheduled for completion in March. Once the project is complete, the intention is to mill and pave Kings Highway from the borough line to Caroline Drive. The estimated construction cost is anticipated to be \$140,000.00-\$160,000.00. The other major project involves separating the sanitary sewer system from the storm sewer system in the square area from SR 850 to the Subway. Currently the system is combined and the borough is obligated to begin separating the system. The estimated construction cost is anticipated to be \$125,000.00.

In an effort to mitigate the cost of separating 30,000 linear feet of combined system in the borough, the borough is applying for state and federal monies to begin separating the system in additional sections of the borough. The estimated construction cost to separate the system is anticipated to be \$190.00-\$200.00 per linear foot. Should no funds be received, it is not likely that a project of this magnitude will come to fruition.

The Rockville Estates Subdivision Plan is anticipated to be on the April and May Planning Commission agenda. The preliminary plan was approved by the Planning Commission and Borough Council and now the developer must submit phase plans for the development.

We would also like to welcome our newest council member, Heather Casale. Heather was sworn in at the February council meeting.

As always, please stay informed and attend the monthly meeting of the Borough Council. The council meets the second Monday of every month at 7:30pm.

### Membership Rules

- Family Memberships are limited to use by members of an individual's immediate family which are:
  - \*spouses, live in companions, children or step children
  - \*under the age of 18 living in the same household
  - \*an individual's grandchild who is living with the individual for the summer may be included
  - \*grandparents who watch a grandchild(ren)

*you may be asked to provide proof of residency or identification*
- Other relatives living with the family (ex. brothers, sisters, aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, etc.) must purchase their own membership.
- Memberships are *NON-TRANSFERABLE*. Anyone letting others use their cards will face automatic loss of membership. No refund will be given.
- A \$5.00 replacement fee will be charged for lost cards.
- Membership cards *MUST BE SHOWN TO GAIN ADMITTANCE TO THE POOL* or the daily admission fee will be charged.

### Closing Policy

We reserve the right to close the pool for the following reasons:

- \* Inclement Weather (rain, storms, cold temperatures)
- \* Low attendance (less than 10 people in the water)
- \* Emergency Situations
- \* Lack of availability of lifeguards
- \* Pre-scheduled events (private pool rentals, fundraiser events, etc.)

Public Swim: Monday - Friday 12:00noon - 8:00pm, Saturday and Sunday 12:00noon - 7:00pm

Private Pool Rental: Fridays 7:00pm - 9:00pm, Saturdays and Sundays 6:00pm - 8:00pm

## Marysville Borough Pool Rules and Regulations

- All persons who enter the pool do so at their own risk. We are not responsible for any accident, injury, theft or damage to personal property.
- Smoking and alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
- Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a person 16 or older who will accept responsibility for the safety and conduct of the child. Individuals found irresponsible will be asked to leave the pool.
- No running, pushing, spitting, rough housing, profanity, or lewd behavior permitted.
- No glass containers, metal or bulky items are permitted in the pool area.
- Adult swims: adults may take their children 6 and younger, into the shallow end. The deep end of the pool is for adults 18 years and older. The adult swims are at the discretion of the lifeguards.
- Lifeguards may refuse a swimmer admission to any pool area if the swimmer does not exhibit sufficient skill to insure his/her safety.
- In case of an accident, report it immediately to a lifeguard or the Pool Manager.
- Management reserves the right to refuse admission to anyone with skin abrasions, colds, coughs, inflamed eyes, athlete's feet, infectious disorders, communicable diseases, or persons wearing band-aids.
- The cost of any property damage shall be charged to the responsible member, including damage caused by the guest of the member.
- Any member allowing another person to use his/her pool pass may result in suspension of pool privileges.
- Thongs are prohibited
- All swimmers must wear a bathing suit or bathing trunks.
- Showers are required before swimming.

### WADING/BABY POOL

- The wading/baby pool is not under the immediate supervision of a lifeguard. Parents and/or Guardians are reminded that children in the wading/baby pool are ***THEIR*** responsibility.
- Children in diapers are required to wear swim diapers.
- The wading/baby pool is for children under the age of 6.

### SLIDES

- No horseplay, pushing, running or cutting in line.
- You must slide and enter the pool feet first.
- Clear the landing area or exit the pool by the ladder.
- One slider at a time—no stopping.

### DIVING BOARD

- If you are using the diving board for the first time you may be asked to show a lifeguard you can swim a section of the pool.
- Only one person at a time is allowed on the board; only bounce is permitted.
- You may NOT enter the water backwards or dive to the side.
- After diving please exit the area immediately.
- Be courteous and patient when there are smaller children on the diving board and in the water below.

Any objectionable activities or items not covered in the above rules and regulations will be judged by the Pool Manager.

**The Pool Manager and/or any other personnel are the absolute authority and may discipline, suspend or dismiss any pool member or guest who violates pool rules. Serious or successive violations may be sufficient cause for cancellation of membership with no refund.**

**PARENTS:** Instruct your children and urge them to read and observe all rules and to obey the Pool Manager, lifeguards and other employees.






