

The Manager's Corner

The Trout Run Sanitary Sewer Replacement and Bank Stabilization Project is complete. The project included replacing 320 linear feet of 8" sanitary sewer main on Kings Highway and restored the walls at the stream embankment located in front of Little Mountain Estates. The infrastructure has been updated and paving of Kings Highway from Caroline Drive to Rye Township will be completed this summer.

The new wading pool is now complete and ready for the summer pool season. The zero entry wading pool was installed by Vision Pools of Downingtown. In addition to the wading pool replacement, additional improvements were made to the large pool to comply with the Virginia Graham-Baker Act. More information is available in this newsletter regarding the pool.


The Rockville Estates Final Phase One subdivision plan has been presented to the Borough Council. Phase 1 includes 33 residential homes on Kittochinny Drive. As part of phase one, a traffic signal will be installed at the intersection of SR 11/15 and SR 850 and an entrance into the development from SR 11/15 will be constructed.

With the growing season upon us, residents are reminded that the borough has an ordinance restricting grass and weeds above 6". In addition, residents are reminded that residential refuse collection is restricted to four bags per household and one large item per week.

The owner of the property shall trim branches from any shade trees overhanging the streets and highways of the borough so that they will not obstruct the light from any street light, and so that there shall be a clear height of 14 feet above the surface of the street and 10 feet over the sidewalk. If any property owner shall neglect or refuse to trim any shade tree as required by this section, upon notice in writing by the Commission within the time limits specified in such notice, the Commission may cause such trimming to be done at the expense of the owner. (ordinance 291-section 10)

Red Cross Learn-To-Swim Program

The Borough of Marysville is holding a Red Cross Learn-to-Swim Program at the Marysville Borough Pool. There will be two sessions offered. The first two weeks will be June 29th to July 10th for levels 4/5 from 8:00am - 9:00am and levels 3/4 from 9:00am - 10:00am. The second two weeks will be July 13th to July 24th for level 2 from 8:30am - 9:15am and level 1 from 9:15am - 10:00am. Please see the levels below.

The cost of the program, per swimmer is \$45.00, which covers the fees for Red Cross instructor, equip., etc. Checks should be payable to Marysville Borough Pool and mailed to 200 Overcrest Road, Marysville, PA 17053.

The program is open to all children age 5 and older. The students must be tall enough to stand in 3 feet of water with their head above the water. There will be a maximum of 60 children in the program.

Classes are filled on a first come, first serve basis with paid registration.

Children must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. Please save these instructions for future reference.




