Marysville Borough News

As Summer turns to Fall, we are beginning to prepare the 2010 budget for the borough. The borough has four major funds: General, Sewer, State Highway Aid and the Pool Fund. The general fund is a governmental fund and includes tax revenue which funds the majority of the services the borough provides. The sewer fund is a proprietary fund that operates on sewer rentals and is used to finance the waste water treatment plant and infrastructure. The state highway aid fund and the pool fund are much smaller and are used for street maintenance and pool operations.

Kings Highway was selected as the major road paving project for 2009 and was completed by Womex Inc. out of Dillsburg. The project included milling and repaving of Kings Highway from Caroline Drive to Rye Township and widening the road by five feet to incorporate a walking / biking path for residents. Roads are recommended by the Streets Committee based on the condition of the road and the amount of traffic the road receives.

The Rockville Estates Subdivision began this summer and Phase 1 construction will begin this fall. The work that has been undertaken includes the PennDOT required improvements on State Route 11/15. This includes installing the storm-water infrastructure in the right-of-way and widening SR 11/15. The traffic signal at State Route 850 and 11/15 is scheduled for installation in late fall early winter. Phase 1 includes 33 single family residential homes located south of Ridgeview Drive. Homes are expected to be marketed in late 2010.

As part of the borough's ongoing effort to maximize water quality entering the Susquehanna River and the Chesapeake Bay watershed, residents are reminded that the borough has three combined sewer outfalls along the river. The outfalls discharge into the river during high flow events when the system receives substantial rainfall in short periods of time. Residents are reminded that it is illegal to dump or discharge substances into storm sewer

inlets. In addition, grit and debris that enters the system contributes to impeding flow in the lines. In an effort to mitigate this, the borough routinely sweeps the streets and vacuums the lines. As always, please stay informed and attend the monthly meeting of the Borough Council. The council meets the second Monday of every month at 7:30pm. Also, be sure to mark your calendar for the November 3rd Municipal Election.

Have You Brought Your Sewer Arrears Up to Date?

The Borough has aggressively been pursuing collection of monthly sewer charges for those residents that are in arrears. While the Boroughs effort has been moderately successful, the total unpaid charges are still in excess of \$29,000.00.

The Borough has current financial obligations that must be met on a monthly basis and will continue to aggressively pursue the arrears owed. In addition to placing liens on properties with serious arrears, the Borough has an agreement with United Water to terminate public water service after notifying the resident and properly posting the property. Any charges associated with the termination of public water service would also be the responsibility of the property owner.

The Borough encourages anyone who receives a notice regarding arrears to contact the Borough office at 957-3110 to make arrangements to bring their account up to date. The Borough is willing to establish a payment plan if the account balance cannot be paid in full.

Leaf Collection

Leaf collection will begin October 26th and end December 4th.

The south end (Valley Street to Ridgeview Drive) of the borough will be collected on Mondays and Wednesdays.

The north end (Valley Street to Sylvan Street) of the borough will be collected on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

North Main Street, South Main Street and the adjoining streets will be collected on Fridays.

If your street was not collected on your designated day due to inclement weather, the leaves will be collected on Friday.

If you live on Valley Street, please call the borough office at 957-3110 to have your leaves put on the schedule to be picked up.

Where possible, without blocking lanes, place leaves on street pavement. Where curbs are present. Keep a foot of pavement cleared between curb and leaf piles.

Be sure that only leaves are in the piles. Sticks, rocks pieces of wood and other debris can cause serious damage to the collection equipment and will not be picked up.

There will be no special pickups.

The Marysville Ambulance Association is offering CPR classes. We now have four certified instructors for CPR.

The classes we are able to offer

are BLS for health care providers, Heart Saver and AED, as well as Heart Saver First Aid.

We are only asking you to cover the

cost of the registration for the class, which is through H.A.C.C. The cost for the BLS for health care providers class is \$65.00 plus \$5.00 for each card issued. The Heart Saver and AED class is \$30.00 plus \$5.00 for each card issued. The Heart Saver First Aid class is \$75.00 plus \$5.00 for each card issued. The price is to cover a whole class not just an individual. So, the more in the class the less the cost to each student.

We have a clean facility here at the Fire House with up to date equipment


and training manikins. We are also available to have the classes at your place of business. Each class can have up to 24 students with our instructors.

Angel Food Ministries has come to Marysville-Rye Township with boxes of fresh or frozen food for less than you'd usually pay in the supermarket. The "signature box" is always \$30 and includes food for a family of four for a week worth at least \$50-\$60. Other specials, such as frozen meals, fresh produce, frozen meat combos and holiday specials are available as well. Distribution is usually the third Saturday of the month (though in November and December it will be the second Saturday) at Bethany UMC, 400 Lansvale Street, Marysville from 11:00-12:30. Ordering (all orders must be placed in advance) can be done on that day or a week or two before (please contact Wesley UMC at 957-4485 for specific information) on Thursday evening at Wesley (top of Sylvan Street, Marysville) or Saturday morning at Bethel UMC (Valley Road at Griers Point). Orders must be prepaid in cash, money order or food stamps (EBT). Anyone may order in any quantity. 


