Dear Pool Member:

If you are interested in joining the Marysville Borough Pool please read the information page, rules/regulations and complete the 2012 membership application. Please bring the completed application to the Marysville Borough Office, 200 Overcrest Road, Marysville, PA 17053.

Returning Members

If you are a returning member and did not return your membership card please bring the membership card(s) with you when you pay so it can be punched. If you lost or misplaced your card there will be a \$5.00 charge and you will need to have your picture retaken.

New Members

If you are a new member you will need to have your picture taken. Children who are four years of age or younger will not need to have their picture taken since there is no charge to gain admission to the pool. It is not necessary to have all members of the family present at the same time for pictures to be taken. All pictures will be taken at the Marysville Borough Office (please see the picture taken schedule below) no pictures will be taken at the pool. Once the pool season begins applications and payment can be dropped off at the pool and you can enter for the day however; you will need to get a picture ID card for your membership before your next visit to the pool.

Pool members must present their photo ID to gain admission to the pool.

Membership Rules

- Family Memberships are limited to use by members of an individual's immediate family which are:
 - *spouses, live in companions, children or step children
 - *under the age of 19 living in the same household
 - *full time students or active Military included to age 22
you may be asked to provide proof of residency or identification
- Grandparents are permitted on the family membership. The following stipulation will apply: In order for the grandparents to gain admittance to the pool the grandchild(ren) must be present or a daily pass will need to be purchased.
- Other relatives living with the family (ex. brothers, sisters, aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, etc.) must purchase their own membership.
Memberships are *NON-TRANSFERABLE*. Anyone letting others use their cards will face automatic loss of membership. No refund will be given.
- A \$5.00 replacement fee will be charged for lost cards.
- Membership cards *MUST BE SHOWN TO GAIN ADMITTANCE TO THE POOL* or the daily admission fee will be charged.

Closing Policy

We reserve the right to close the pool for the following reasons:

- * Inclement Weather (rain, storms, cold temperatures)
- * Low attendance (less than 10 people in the water)
- * Emergency Situations
- * Lack of availability of lifeguards
- * Pre-scheduled events (private pool rentals, fundraiser events, etc.)

Pool Rules and Regulations

- All persons who enter the pool do so at their own risk. We are not responsible for any accident, injury, theft or damage to personal property.
- Smoking and alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
- Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a person 16 or older who will accept responsibility for the safety and conduct of the child. Individuals found irresponsible will be asked to leave the pool.
- No running, pushing, spitting, rough housing, profanity, or lewd behavior permitted.
- No glass containers, metal or bulky items are permitted in the pool area.
- Adult swims: adults may take their children 6 and younger, into the shallow end. The deep end of the pool is for adults 18 years and older. The adult swims are at the discretion of the lifeguards.
- Lifeguards may refuse a swimmer admission to any pool area if the swimmer does not exhibit sufficient skill to insure his/her safety.
- In case of an accident, report it immediately to a lifeguard or the Pool Manager.
- Management reserves the right to refuse admission to anyone with skin abrasions, colds, coughs, inflamed eyes, athlete's feet, infectious disorders, communicable diseases, or persons wearing band-aids.
- The cost of any property damage shall be charged to the responsible member, including damage caused by the guest of the member.
- Any member allowing another person to use his/her pool pass may result in suspension of pool privileges.
- Thongs are prohibited.
- All swimmers must wear a bathing suit or bathing trunks.
- Showers are required before swimming.

WADING/BABY POOL

- The wading/baby pool is not under the immediate supervision of a lifeguard. Parents and/or Guardians are reminded that children in the wading/baby pool are ***THEIR*** responsibility.
- Children in diapers are required to wear swim diapers.
- The wading/baby pool is for children under the age of 6.

SLIDES

- No horseplay, pushing, running or cutting in line.
- You must slide and enter the pool feet first.
- Clear the landing area or exit the pool by the ladder.
- One slider at a time—no stopping.

DIVING BOARD

- If you are using the diving board for the first time you may be asked to show a lifeguard you can swim a section of the pool.
- Only one person at a time is allowed on the board; only one bounce is permitted.
- You may NOT enter the water backwards or dive to the side.
- After diving please exit the area immediately.
- Be courteous and patient when there are smaller children on the diving board and in the water below.

Any objectionable activities or items not covered in the above rules and regulations will be judged by the Pool Manager.

The Pool Manager and/or any other personnel are the absolute authority and may discipline, suspend or dismiss any pool member or guest who violates pool rules. Serious or successive violations may be sufficient cause for cancellation of membership with no refund.

PARENTS: Instruct your children and urge them to read and observe all rules and to obey the Pool Manager, lifeguards and other employees.

Do your remember when.....

To decide on sending township school pupils to the Marysville school.

School directors of Rye Township have announced a public meeting on Friday, August 29, 1947, when the question of sending Township pupils to Marysville schools will be discussed. The meeting will be held in the evening at this Keystone school, beginning at eight o'clock.

Announcement issued over the names of Mrs. Margaret Walker, president, and Samuel Adams secretary, say, the directors are anxious to meet as many patrons as possible since the move would involve closing of three township schools.

Ralph Swann Avenue, Bloomfield, County Superintendent of schools, may be present to discuss various phases of the matter.

School pupils of the township now attend Marysville schools, but are forced to find their own means of transportation. Within two years, under the recently enacted legislation, the Township will be compelled to provide means of travel for these pupils. Some Township grade pupils are attending the borough schools with parents responsible for transportation and tuition charges.

A statement from the County superintendent of schools office made at a recent conference of township with Marysville borough directors, is to the effect that township could be sent to Marysville with little, if any, additional charge to township.

Rye Township votes to send pupils to Marysville.

A proposal to close four schools of Rye Township was endorsed last week at a meeting of the local residents. School board this week will consider at sending 115 grade pupils to schools here for the 1948 - 49 term. The Township now sends 20 pupils to Marysville high

Mrs. Margaret Welker, president of the Rye Township board, said transportation costs to Marysville would be nominal. She advocated consolidation citing difficulties in obtaining an adequate teaching staff in rural communities.

Kermit Stover, supervising principal of Marysville schools said spaces are available for Rye pupils. Marysville voters in November will pass upon a proposed bond issue to enlarge the high school so that it may offer Junior - Senior courses. This would open additional rooms in the grade building.

The 165 pupils of Tressler High school, boys will, which has been closed, will attend Landis Berg High school during the 1947 - 48 school year. Ralph C Swann, County Superintendent of schools announced last week.

For closing the Tressler school cannot be considered as a merger with Landisburg, Swann said residents of Seville, Tyrone, spring townships and Landisburg will vote this fall. It would proposed merger of schools for the four districts.

If the merger is approved pupils continue to attend their present high schools at Landisburg and Ickesburg. Swann disclosed, until the erection of a consolidated school combining trust or Landisburg and Ickesburg.

The teachers have been elected to fill remaining vacancies in the borough schools, Kermit Stover, supervising principal announced last week. Schools will open on September 2, 1947.

Ms. Gertrude Seavers, of Shippensburg, has been elected music supervisor and Mrs. Lois Thomas, Duncannon, is a new first-grade teacher.

High school students will report; Tuesday morning, September 2, at 9 o'clock, while grade school to 1 PM. All new pupils and first-grade entrance will register on the first day of school. Stover said first-grade pupils must be six years old by February 1, 1948.

At the school board meeting last Tuesday evening, Archie G Eppley, senior resigned from the borough school board. William T. Keller, was named at the board meeting to fill the vacancy.



Gutshall, of Valley Street, about 4 AM on August 13, police said. The two took a number of hunting and pocket knives, a wrist-watch and several pen and pencil sets with the total value of \$50.

Stone was given a hearing before Justice of the Peace, Frank Milligan, of Newport, and was without bail in new Bloomfield for court action.

Assisting in the arrest were police chief William Donovan, of Marysville, and Pfc. Ronald W. Wagner, of the State Police.

Donovan said most of the loot and then recovered and he expects to obtain the remainder soon.
