Letter from Borough Council

Dear Borough Residents,

Having been informed by the Marysville Ambulance Association that will no longer have services at the end of April. We deemed it necessary to ask the borough residents if they would be willing to pay a property tax not to exceed two mills to provide ambulance service to the community. Therefore, there will be a non-binding referendum on the ballot in May and would require a yes or no vote. We hope to hold several community meetings prior to voting to better inform you of our thoughts and plans.

Please bare in mind until a decision has been made a service contract has been signed with East Pennsboro Ambulance Service, Inc. to provide the ambulance service for a year. This contract has options for renewal.



January 2015 - March 2015

- ◇ Approved to return the M&T Bond for the Sewer Separation Project.
- ◇ Approved to accept Pennoni's rate schedule.
- ◇ Approved to advertise for a part-time police officer.
- ◇ Approved to exonerate 334 Cameron Street from the tax roles. The Marysville Fire Company owns the property. All utilities have been disconnected. The Marysville Fire Company is planning on using 334 Cameron Street for firemen training prior to the demolition of the structure.
- ◇ Approved unanimously to subscribe to the Municipal Planning Advisory Service for its Planning Commission as part-time for a cost of \$500.00, for the calendar year 2015.
- ◇ Approved unanimously to accept Rockville Estates Bond Reduction of \$623,195.35 for Phase 1.
- ◇ Approved unanimously to accept the 2015 proposed pool salaries.
- ◇ Approved unanimously to accept the quote from Keystone Conveyor Corporation for the shielding of Auger for a total price of \$2,500.00.
- ◇ Approved unanimously to advertise the BID for the demolition of 114 Valley Street Ext.
- ◇ Approved unanimously to rescind the motion to advertise to hire a part-time police officer.
- ◇ Approved unanimously to adopt the Resolution to allow Municipal Police to use same motor vehicle speed timing equipment as the Pennsylvania State Police.

- ◇ Approved unanimously to award Redrock Construction, Inc, of P.O. Box 150 Mifflintown, PA 17059 the bid for 114 Valley Street Demolition Project, Contract 2015-01 for the cost of \$12,650.00.

Police News

After a long and cold winter, hopefully this newsletter finds us with milder temperatures. Warmer temperatures means Street Sweeping will continue in the Borough. Residents are reminded Street Sweeping takes place on the 3rd Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday of each month. Please take notice to the posted signs to avoid parking tickets.

Warmer temperatures also increase the outside activity of children in the Borough. Parents, please help ensure your children's safety by making them wear helmets when riding bicycles and scooters. PA laws require all children under the age of 12 wear an approved helmet when riding a bicycle or scooter. Parents are also reminded Marysville Borough has a Curfew Ordinance. Curfew for minors under age 14 years is 10pm, for minors between age 14 and 18 years, curfew is 11pm.

Residents are reminded it is unlawful to let cats and dogs run at large. ALL cats and dogs must be leashed or under direct physical control at all times. Owners are also responsible for picking up and properly disposing of their pet's waste. For those using the Memorial Walking Path at the Marysville Lions Club, plastic bags and disposal containers are provided for pet waste.

East Pennsboro Ambulance Service, Inc. is a not-for-profit service, governed by a volunteer Board of Directors. Our career staffing is on station 24 hours-a-day to provide immediate response to service requests.



East Pennsboro Ambulance Service, Inc. has been providing medical support for East Pennsboro Township and surrounding communities since 1987.

In addition to our emergency division, East Pennsboro Ambulance Service, Inc. provides non-emergency ambulance, wheelchair and stretcher transportation services. These services are available to transport patients for hospital discharges, doctor appointments, dialysis appointments, etc.

Marysville Ambulance Association has been a staple in the Marysville community for 30 years, but has found it difficult to provide ambulance service to the community due to decreases in qualified volunteers. Marysville Ambulance Association still intends to take an active part in the community, but will rely on East Pennsboro Ambulance Service, Inc. to assist in patient care and transport patients to emergency departments within our region.



Residents of the community will continue to request assistance for medical emergencies by calling 911. East Pennsboro Ambulance Service, Inc. will be notified of your medical emergency and respond to help you in your time of need. If East Pennsboro Ambulance Service, Inc. is not available surrounding EMS agencies will be dispatched by the 911 center.

Annual Membership Subscription Program

Emergency ambulance service for residents of East Pennsboro Township, Marysville Borough and Rye Township are supported through an Annual Membership Subscription Program.

Residents of Marysville Borough and Rye Township will receive a Subscription Application in the mail. The Subscription Program will run from **May 1, 2015 to April 30, 2016.**

Benefits of Membership

The Subscription Program provides unlimited pre-hospital care and transportation services to emergency departments within Cumberland and Dauphin Counties.

Paid subscribers will not be responsible for any outstanding co-pays or deductibles not paid by health insurance for emergency medical services provided by East Pennsboro Ambulance Service, Inc. or paramedic services provided by Holy Spirit EMS, formerly known at West Shore EMS.

East Pennsboro Ambulance Service, Inc. reciprocates with many surrounding EMS Agencies. If you need emergency medical services while visiting neighboring communities, your paid subscription will be honored by many local EMS Agencies in our area.

Non-emergency transportation services are not covered under the membership subscription program or most health insurance programs, but discounts are provided to Subscription Members.

Membership & Monthly Membership Rules

- Family Memberships are limited to use by members of an individual's immediate family which are: spouses, live in companions, children or step children, *under the age of 19 living in the same household, *full time students or active Military included to age 22 (*you may be asked to provide proof of residency or identification*). Grandparents are permitted on the family membership. In order for the grandparents to gain admittance to the pool the grandchild(ren) must be present or a daily pass will need to be purchased.
- Other relatives living with the family (ex. brothers, sisters, aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, etc.) must purchase their own membership.
- Memberships are non-transferable. Anyone letting others use their cards will face automatic loss of membership. No refund will be given.
- A \$5.00 replacement fee will be charged for lost cards.
- Membership cards must be shown to gain admittance to the pool or the daily admission fee will be charged.

- ⇒ May 30th – June 3rd from 12:00pm – 6:00pm - If we have three lifeguards available.
- ⇒ June 4th – End of School Pool Party - Must pay to enter pool even if you purchased a membership or punch card.
- ⇒ July 27th – August 1st from 12:00pm – 5:00pm (Marysville Lions Club Carnival)
- ⇒ The day before school starts (the date needs to be determined) the pool will be open from 11:00am – 5:00pm
- ⇒ September 5th, September 6th and September 7th from 12:00pm – 6:00pm – If we have three lifeguards available.

Hours may vary due to private pool parties, fundraisers, guard availability, etc.

Closing Policy

We reserve the right to close the pool for the following reasons: Inclement Weather (rain, storms, cold temperatures), Low attendance (less than 10 people in the water), Emergency Situations, Lack of availability of lifeguards, Pre-scheduled events (private pool rentals, fundraiser events, etc.)

Membership Cards and Punch Cards

There will be no Photo ID membership cards. Each person will be issued a new membership card with your name and member number. Cards can be picked up at the pool when it opens.

Marysville Pool Rules and Regulations

- All persons who enter the pool do so at their own risk. We are not responsible for any accident, injury, theft or damage to personal property.
- Smoking and alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
- Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a person 16 or older who will accept responsibility for the safety and conduct of the child. Individuals found irresponsible will be asked to leave the pool.
- No running, pushing, spitting, rough housing, profanity, or lewd behavior permitted.
- No glass containers, metal or bulky items are permitted in the pool area.
- Adult swims: adults may take their children 6 and younger, into the shallow end. The deep end of the pool is for adults 18 years and older. The adult swims are at the discretion of the lifeguards.
- Lifeguards may refuse a swimmer admission to any pool area if the swimmer does not exhibit sufficient skill to insure his/her safety.
- In case of an accident, report it immediately to a lifeguard or the Pool Manager.
- Management reserves the right to refuse admission to anyone with skin abrasions, colds, coughs, inflamed eyes, athlete's feet, infectious disorders, communicable diseases, or persons wearing Band-Aids.
- The cost of any property damage shall be charged to the responsible member, including damage caused by the guest of the member.
- Any member allowing another person to use his/her pool pass may result in suspension of pool privileges.
- Thongs are prohibited.
- All swimmers must wear a bathing suit or bathing trunks.
- Showers are required before swimming.

WADING/BABY POOL

- The wading/baby pool is not under the immediate supervision of a lifeguard. Parents and/or Guardians are reminded that children in the wading/baby pool are **THEIR** responsibility.
- Children in diapers are required to wear swim diapers.
- The wading/baby pool is for children under the age of 6.

SLIDES

- No horseplay, pushing, running or cutting in line.
- You must slide and enter the pool feet first.
- Clear the landing area or exit the pool by the ladder.
- One slider at a time—no stopping.

DIVING BOARD

- If you are using the diving board for the first time you may be asked to show a lifeguard you can swim a section of the pool.
- Only one person at a time is allowed on the board; only bounce is permitted.
- You may NOT enter the water backwards or dive to the side.
- After diving please exit the area immediately.
- Be courteous and patient when there are smaller children on the diving board and in the water below.

Any objectionable activities or items not covered in the above rules and regulations will be judged by the Pool Manager/Lifeguards.

The Pool Manager and/or any other personnel are the absolute authority and may discipline, suspend or dismiss any pool member or guest who violates pool rules. Serious or successive violations may be sufficient cause for cancellation of membership with no refund.

PARENTS: Instruct your children and urge them to read and observe all rules and to obey the Pool Manager, lifeguards and other employees.




