Police News



School is out and summer is finally here. The Marysville Borough Police Department would like to remind parents that all children under age 12 **MUST** wear a helmet at all times while riding their bikes. Borough Ordinance also states it is unlawful to ride skateboards/scooters on streets and sidewalks. Parents are also reminded of the Borough's Curfew Ordinance. Curfew for minors under 14 years of age is 10pm. Curfew for minors between 14 and 18 years of age 11:00pm. Exceptions are if the minor is accompanied by a parent or an adult authorized by a parent to accompany said minor for a designated period of time and purpose within a specified area.

Street sweeping has resumed now that the sewer separation and paving projects are complete. Mark your calendar for the 3rd Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday depending where you live. Street sweeping is conducted unless heavy rains, leaves on the roadway, freezing temperatures, or mechanical break-downs prevent efficient operation of the street sweeper. For questions, contact the borough office from 7:00am-3:00pm.

Residents are reminded, at the intersection of Valley ST (SR850) and State RD (SR11/15), "No Turn on Red" means, no turn on red. We have been enforcing this and will continue to do so. Also, stop signs mean stop, then proceed with caution through the intersection. Slow and go (California stop) violators will be cited. The main portions of Verbeke St and Lincoln St are one-way streets, please be observant and obey our street signs throughout the borough.



The "new" Burning Ordinance should be in effect within a few weeks of this newsletter. The "new" Ordinance will allow burning in patio fireplaces with certain restrictions; must be 25' from a structure, covered by 1/4" mesh screen, 8:00am to 10pm, and only wood products and yard debris. Please use good judgment and respect your neighbors when utilizing any burning container.

Although we have not experienced as much activity as past years, black bears still come into the borough. It is unlawful to specifically target feed black bear in Pennsylvania. Bird feeders, both seed and nectar water feeders, are attractive to bear. If you feed birds during the summer and fall we urge you to take your feeders in at night. Remember it is also unlawful to set out your trash out more than 12 hours prior to collection. Our department has been working with the Pennsylvania Game Commission to address human/bear conflicts during the past few years. For the 2014-15 Hunting Season, the PGC has extended bear season in our management unit (4B) to include a portion of the regular firearms deer season. This is in an attempt to locally control bear numbers, and reduce human/bear conflicts. Please report any bear damage or conflicts to our department at (717)957-2616.

A reminder to our residents, our department does conduct vacation checks for your residence. Forms can be picked up at the borough office, filled out, and returned to the borough office or police station.






During the small group discussion time, you'll have the opportunity to interact with others who have experienced a recent loss, learn about their experiences and share your own.

You are welcome to begin attending the GriefShare group at any session. Each is "self-contained," so you do not have to attend in sequence.



Ordinance Reminders

§10-102. Grass, Weeds and Other Vegetation Unlawful and a Nuisance Under Certain Conditions.

No person, owning or occupying any property within the Borough of Marysville, shall permit any grass or weeds or any vegetation whatsoever, not edible or planted for some useful or ornamental purpose, to grow or remain upon such premises so as to exceed a height of 6 inches, or to throw off any unpleasant or noxious odor or to conceal any filthy deposit or to create or produce pollen. Any grass, weeds or other vegetation growing upon any premises in the Borough in violation of any of the provisions of this Section is hereby declared to be a nuisance and detrimental to the health, safety, cleanliness and comfort of the inhabitants of the Borough.

§10-103. Responsibility for Removing, Trimming or Cutting Grass, Weeds and Other Vegetation.

The owner of any premises, as to vacant premises or premises occupied by the owner, and the occupant thereof, in case of premises occupied by other than the owner thereof, shall remove, trim or cut all grass, weeds or other vegetation growing or remaining upon such premises in violation of any of the provisions of §10-102.

§21-206. Duty of Property Owners Following Notice to Construct, Reconstruct, or Repair Sidewalk and/or Curb.

When the Borough Council shall order a sidewalk and/or curb to be constructed or reconstructed upon or along any street in the Borough by and at the expense of the owner of the abutting property, the Council shall notify the owner of such property to complete the construction or reconstruction of the same, in strict conformity with the Borough specifications therefore, within 30 days after such notice. When the Borough shall order a sidewalk and/or curb to be repaired upon or along any street in the Borough by and at the expense of the owner of the abutting property, the Council shall notify the owner of such property to complete the repair of the same within 30 days after such notice, such work or repair to be done in the manner and to the extent specified in such notice and in strict conformity with the provisions of such notice. Any failure, refusal or neglect of such property owner to complete such work in conformity with specifications, within the said time limit, shall give the Borough authority to proceed under § 1805 of the Borough Code of 1966 to do, complete or rectify the said work and to collect the cost thereof, plus 10% from such property owner in default.

Pool Private Party Rental


The pool can be rented from 7:00pm - 9:00pm Monday - Friday and 6:00pm - 8:00pm on Saturday and Sunday.




