Police News

School is out and summer is finally here. The Marysville Borough Police Department would like to remind parents that all children under age 12 **MUST** wear a helmet at all times while riding their bikes. Borough Ordinance also states it is unlawful to ride skateboards/scooters on streets and sidewalks. Parents are also reminded of the Borough's Curfew Ordinance. Curfew for minors age 14 and under is 10pm. Curfew for minor's age 15 to 17 years old is 11pm. Exceptions are if the minor is accompanied by a parent or an adult authorized by a parent to accompany said minor for a designated period of time and purpose within a specified area.

Please use caution and patients around the ongoing construction on SR 11/15 at the Subway overpass. The bridge replacement is continuing as scheduled, road closures and updates will be posted on our facebook page.

Street sweeper is now repaired. Mark your calendar for the 3rd Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday depending where you live. For questions, contact the borough office from 7am—3pm or check our Facebook page.

Although we have not experienced as much activity as past years, black bears still come into the borough. It is unlawful to specifically target feed black bear in Pennsylvania. Bird feeders, both seed and nectar water feeders, are attractive to bear. If you feed birds during the summer and fall we urge you to take your feeders in at night. Remember it is also unlawful to set out your trash out more than 12 hours prior to collection. Our department has been working with the Pennsylvania Game Commission to address human/bear conflicts during the past few years. Please report any bear damage or conflicts to our department at (717)957-2616.

A reminder to our residents, our department does conduct vacation checks for your residence. Forms can be picked up at the borough office, filled out, and returned to the borough office or police station.

Marysville Parks, Pool and Recreation Foundation

The Marysville Borough Council held several meetings inviting the public to come and discuss how to make the pool financially sound and remain open for years to come. The first meeting welcomed over 50 people, the second meeting attendance dropped to about 15 people and by the next several meetings there were only a handful of people attending. The idea was to formulate a committee of volunteers to brainstorm and develop fundraisers to support the daily function of the pool as well as cover future repair costs as the pool equipment ages and needs replaced.

On May 6, 2015 the Marysville Park, Pool and Recreation Foundation was formed. Directors and officers were elected. The President of the Foundation is Rich Stees, Vice-President - Tom Speck, Treasurer - Kristine Kuhn and Secretary - Zina Speck. This committee has been meeting every two weeks at the Borough office. Meeting dates and times can be found on the Borough website or by calling 957-3110. The goal is to develop and hold fundraisers throughout the year to support the pool and ensure its financial success, despite the age of the equipment.

The foundation has already had a 5K Kolor Run that was held at the Lion's Club Park on June 20th. The Kolor Run was a huge success! The next Kolor Run is scheduled for Saturday, October 24, 2015. There are several ideas being discussed currently.

The Borough and the Foundation welcome any input, fundraising ideas, volunteers and help at planned events. Come out and help keep the pool open for years to come!! The Borough continues to have ownership and financial support will continue to be included in their annual budget.

Ordinance Reminders

§10-102. Grass, Weeds and Other Vegetation Unlawful and a Nuisance Under Certain Conditions.

No person, owning or occupying any property within the Borough of Marysville, shall permit any grass or weeds or any vegetation whatsoever, not edible or planted for some useful or ornamental purpose, to grow or remain upon such premises so as to exceed a height of 6 inches, or to throw off any unpleasant or noxious odor or to conceal any filthy deposit or to create or produce pollen. Any grass, weeds or other vegetation growing upon any premises in the Borough in violation of any of the provisions of this Section is hereby declared to be a nuisance and detrimental to the health, safety, cleanliness and comfort of the inhabitants of the Borough. (Ord. 222, 1/8/1968, §2)

§10-103. Responsibility for Removing, Trimming or Cutting Grass, Weeds and Other Vegetation.

The owner of any premises, as to vacant premises or premises occupied by the owner, and the occupant thereof, in case of premises occupied by other than the owner thereof, shall remove, trim or cut all grass, weeds or other vegetation growing or remaining upon such premises in violation of any of the provisions of §10-102. (Ord. 222, 1/8/1968, §3)

§21-206. Duty of Property Owners Following Notice to Construct, Reconstruct, or Repair Sidewalk and/or Curb.

When the Borough Council shall order a sidewalk and/or curb to be constructed or reconstructed upon or along any street in the Borough by and at the expense of the owner of the abutting property, the Council shall notify the owner of such property to complete the construction or reconstruction of the same, in strict conformity with the Borough specifications therefore, within 30 days after such notice. When the Borough shall order a sidewalk and/or curb to be repaired upon or along any street in the Borough by and at the expense of the owner of the abutting property, the Council shall notify the owner of such property to complete the repair of the same within 30 days after such notice, such work or repair to be done in the manner and to the extent specified in such notice and in strict conformity with the provisions of such notice. Any failure, refusal or neglect of such property owner to complete such work in conformity with specifications, within the said time limit, shall give the Borough authority to proceed under § 1805 of the Borough Code of 1966 to do, complete or rectify the said work and to collect the cost thereof, plus 10% from such property owner in default. (Ord.226, 1/8/1968, §1; as amended by Ord. 289, 12/2/1974, §1)

When your street is scheduled for sweeping please be advised that your vehicle must be removed from the street between the hours of 7:00am to 3:00pm. Any vehicle not removed could result in a parking ticket or towing of your vehicle. The street sweeping will be done once a month. Please see below the street sweeping schedule:





Pet Owners Reminders

It shall be unlawful for any person to allow any domestic animal or wild animal to do the following:

- To make any loud or harsh noise or disturbance which shall disturb or interfere with the peace, quiet, rest or sleep of any person within the Borough.
- To defile, corrupt or otherwise befoul any sidewalk, or walkway or the property of another.
- To allow animals to dig into flower beds, lawns, children's sandboxes, gardens or the damaging of shrubbery, trees, lawns, personal property not belonging to the owner of the animal or the depositing of feces as set forth in §2-103(E). *[Ord. 536]*
- No owner shall permit any animal to enter upon any area designated as a publicly owned park or playground. *[Ord. 536]*
- All owners of dogs and cats shall comply with, and be current with rabies vaccination requirements of the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. *[Ord. 536]*



- We have had numerous cases of graffiti on the playground equipment. This costs tax payers money. We must pay our staff to remove the graffiti.





