### Street Sweeping

Street Sweeping will resume in October for residents who live from Valley Street south. ### Leaf Collection

Leaf collection will begin late October and end in the beginning of December.



When your leaves fall you can rake them to the curb. The truck will be around on a daily basis (weather permitting) to pickup the leaves.

Leaf collection guidelines are as follows:

- If you have leaves after leaf collection has been completed it will be your responsibility to dispose of the leaves.
- Where possible without blocking lanes, place leaves on street pavement. Where curbs are present, keep a foot of pavement cleared between curb and leaf piles.
- Be sure that only leaves are in the piles. Sticks, rocks, pieces of wood and other debris can cause serious damage to the collection equipment and delay the schedule.

# Boy Scouts and Cub Scouts



## Police News

---

School is back in session which means bus and kid traffic has increased. Drivers are reminded they must yield to any bus with activated red flashing lights. Drivers are also reminded that the current construction has reduced visibility along many streets and intersections in the borough. Use caution and slow down, keep our kids safe.

Bear Update: The Game Commission did not pass the proposed extended bear season at its June meeting. This decision was based upon concerns of sub—dividing a select area within the management unit. However, the issue will be revisited next year, proposing an extended season for the entire 4B management unit. Bear sightings and encounters decreased during the summer which is normal. As we approach fall, we expect sightings and encounters to drastically increase as bears forage for food in preparation for winter. Bears will be searching for easy, high calorie meals, and during this time of year consume up to 20,000 calories a day. Please do not provide them with an easy food source. It is illegal to intentionally feed bears in PA. Secure

trash cans until the day of pick up. Don't fill bird feeders until late November or early December. If you must feed the birds, take your feeders in overnight. If you encounter a bear, make noise and yell, do not run away. The bears are here, we must learn to live with them. Please report bear encounters to the Pennsylvania Game Commission at (814)643-1831, or Marysville Police Department at (717) 957-2616.

Throughout the summer we have had numerous issues with open burning, mainly patio type fire places. Borough Ordinance 7-105.3(D)1-Each outdoor fire shall be built in and confined to a non-combustible container covered with a screen of 1/2 inch or smaller mesh and located at least 50 feet from any building.

2-Such fires shall be permitted to burn only between the hours of sunrise and sunset.

Residents may burn leaves, weeds, limbs, and brush when said refuse results from the normal occupancy of said structure and provided that a burn permit is first obtained from the Bor-

ough and the above mentioned regulations are strictly adhered to.

Marysville Borough will again be holding a Halloween Parade this year. An exact route has yet to be determined due to ongoing construction in the borough. The parade is scheduled for October 22, 2012 at 6pm. The parade route will be posted, please pay attention to no parking signs to avoid being towed.

Marysville Borough Trick-or-Treat will be held on October 31, 2012 from 6-8pm. Participants are reminded to wear bright colored clothing or reflective material, carry a flash light, and use caution when wearing masks that obstruct your view. Be aware of limited visibility due to construction equipment and materials. Watch for uneven sidewalks and roadways. Utilize crosswalks when navigating the streets. Taking these safety precautions can help ensure a safe and fun Halloween for everyone.

# Tree Branches

---

The owner of the property shall trim branches from any shade trees overhanging the streets and highways of the borough so that they will not obstruct the light from any street light, and so that there shall be a clear height of 14 feet above the sur-

face of the street and 10 feet over the sidewalk. If any property owner shall neglect or refuse to trim any shade tree as required by this section, upon notice in writing by the Commission within the time limits specified in such notice, the Commission

may cause such trimming to be done at the expense of the owner. (ordinance 291-section 10)







# Do You Remember When.....

---

**December 4, 1912, Perry County Democrat**  
**MARYSVILLE**  
**Skelton found in Woods**

While hunting rabbits on the Blue mountain, about two miles from Marysville, on Saturday afternoon, Monroe Whelen, an employee of the railroad shops at Enola, discovered the skeleton of a man. The gruesome find was made in a gully, far up on the mountain side, on woodland owned by Seidel Brothers, where the Big and Little mountains join.

Whelen was poking around an old hollow log, into which a rabbit had run, when underneath the leaves he saw the bones of a human foot. He brushed away more of the leaves and uncovered the entire skeleton of a man. He hastened to Marysville and informed Coroner George W. Gault, but it was then dark, so nothing was done until Sunday, when Coroner Gault and Mr. Whelen went to the spot. Nothing was found by which to discover the identity of the man, or how he came to his death. Suspended from the branch a tree above the log were his belt and suspenders and many think that he committed suicide by hanging, but two ribs of the skeleton were broken, which gives rise to the suspicion that he may have been murdered. The skeleton showed that the man had been of medium height. Small patches of cloth, protected possibly by the leaves, seemed to indicate that his trousers had been blue serge. In a little pile, under what had been a pocket in his suit, was found sixty-five cents in small change and a bill which was so discolored that it was impossible to determine what its denomination was. There was a pair of plated cuff links, and nothing else that may lead to identification. Coroner Gault took charge of the bones and they were buried. It is doubtful if the mystery of who the man was or how he came to his end will ever be solved.

## **Perry County Times, August 5, 1915**

Marysville, Pa., August 3,-- As a result of being hit on the head with a piece of ice weighing thirty pounds, Benjamin Weaver, car inspector for the Pennsylvania Railroad at this place, is at his home with two fractured legs. Weaver was working on a car near FX tower this morning. The relief train was passing at the time. As is the custom every day, ice is delivered to the towers in the Enola and Marysville yards by this train. A large piece was thrown off for FX tower and hit Weaver on the head. In falling his feet caught under the rail and both his legs were broken near the knee in the fall. Weaver was also injured internally and received several gashes on the head.

Ten coaches and one baggage car carried the six hundred persons who attended the third annual Marysville Union Picnic to Mount Gretna last Thursday morning over the Pennsylvania railroad. It was a ideal day and everybody enjoyed themselves to the limit. The swings, see-saws, merry-go-round, movies and little railway were all well patronized, but the lake was the great attraction where hundreds of men, women, boys, and girls donned bathing suits, shot the chutes and played in the sand on the beach.

Last Tuesday morning while attending the lock on a hay wagon being pushed out of the barn on C.R. Miller's farm, Henry Hartman fell over some timbers had been laid as a foundation for a hay stack outside the barn. In falling he released the lock allowing the wagon to run away, the front wheel passing over his left leg breaking both bones between the knee and ankle. He was taken to the Harrisburg hospital, by Amos Keller, where the fracture was reduced.

Jet Trainer Crash In Marysville Area Kills Texas Pilot

An Air Force jet trainer, running low on fuel, as it neared Olmsted Air Force Base crashed into the mountain-side near Marysville early Friday, killing the loan pilot.

The pilot was identified as Capt. John T. Tew, 36, of Randolph Air Force Base, San Antonio, Texas.

A helicopter from Olmsted located the wreckage on Cove Mountain at 11 AM, one hour after it lost radio contact with the base.

## First To Reach The Wreck.

The first persons to reach the wreck was Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Kauffman, Marysville R.D. #1, then a summer home 2 miles a way.

Mrs. Kauffman said she heard a noise "like a bump" about 1:30 AM, but did not think it was a plane crash. When she heard a report of a missing plane later, she and her husband and two neighbors, C. B. Waltz and Russell Krouse, started a search.

Rescue crews reached the wreck on foot and horseback because of the rough terrain. The wreckage was strewn over a quarter of a mile. The closest rescue vehicle could get was about 2 miles.

## Flying at 2500 Feet

Air Force authorities said the Jets altitude was about 2500 feet when contact was lost.

Rescue operations from Olmsted were directed by Maj. J. R. Shrawder. Duncannon State Police, Marysville, West Shore and Duncannon. Rescue teams and that East Pennsboro Civilian Defense unit assisted. A mounted posse from Perry and Cumberland counties was led by Perry County Sheriff Lester W. Fuller.




