

Parks and Recreation Minutes

April 9, 2013

1. Aron Starnowsky (Eagle Scout)
 - Aron supplied a drawing and list of materials for the handrail from Cassel Street down to the park area.
 - The committee agreed on the design and is recommending the "T". Aron will be attending the Parks and Recreation meeting on Tuesday, May 7th with a final cost of the project.
2. Easter Pie Sales
 - Invoice was not received.
3. Pool
 - Vacation Rate
 - The committee agreed not to go with the vacation rate.
 - Pool Parties
 - The committee agreed to have a \$25.00 non-refundable amount for scheduled parties that were canceled.
 - Last Day of School Pool Party – Wednesday, June 5th from 3:30pm – 10:00pm
 - End of School Family Pool Party – Friday, June 7th from 6:00pm – 9:00pm
 - Ice Cream Social – Wednesday – June 19th from 6:00pm – 8:00pm
4. Electric use in the Pump House
 - Kim sent an invoice to the Lions Club on March 13, 2013 Lions Club in the amount \$540.26. No payment has been received.
 - The committee asked Kim to send another invoice if no payment has been received.
5. 2013 Car Show
 - Saturday, May 18, 2013
 - Kitchen – The committee agreed to have Kim contact Holly Bitner to see if the Girl Scouts would be interested in helping in the kitchen. Allen agreed to make the breakfast sandwiches.

7. Bus Trips for 2013 –
 - New York City Bus Trip on Saturday, April 27, 2013 (two buses). 25 seats left
 - Steve asked if there would be someone at the Lions Club to help park cars because the Lions Club is having a bus trip that day as well. Kim agreed to help.

 - Washington DC Smithsonian or National Zoo on Saturday June 22, 2013 - \$1,600.00.
 - \$32.00 per seat
 - **Price Needed** – per person and this includes the gratuity for the bus driver.
 - The committee agreed to charge \$40.00 per person.

 - Baltimore – Inner Harbor “A Day on Your Own” on Saturday, August 17, 2013 - \$1,300.00.
 - \$26.00 per seat
 - **Price Needed** – per person and this includes the gratuity for the bus driver.
 - The committee agreed to charge \$35.00 per person.

 - Day Winery Trip to Finger Lakes on October 12, 2013
 - \$107 per person based on 40 paid and two comps.
 - Includes – 3 wineries and tastings, lunch at Esparanza Mansion and transportation
 - **Price Needed** – per person and this includes the gratuity for the bus driver.
 - The committee agreed to charge \$125.00 per person.

 - New York City Bus Trip on Saturday, December 7, 2013 - \$1,850.00.
 - 47 passenger bus (2 buses)
 - \$40.66 per seat
 - **Price Needed** – per person and this includes the gratuity for the bus driver.
 - The committee agreed to charge \$50.00 per person.

8. 150th Year (2016) Anniversary Celebration
 - Kim placed an article in the newsletter asking for volunteers to help with 150th year Anniversary Celebration that will take place in 2016.

9. Pool
 - The committee discussed the possibility of using Parks and Recreation money to put up a pavilion at the pool. The pavilion size would be 20' x 30'. The price would include the cement slab, building materials and to run conduit to have electricity for the pavilion.
