

Parks and Recreation Meeting Minutes

August 7, 2012

1. Car Show
 - The revenues were \$2,440.50 and expenses were \$1,435.03 with a profit of \$1,005.47.

2. Halloween Parade
 - The parade will be on Monday, October 22, 2012 at 6:00pm with a rain date of Monday, October 29, 2012.
 - The committee asked Scott to contact PennDot for use of the pedestrian walks.
 - The committee discussed having the fire trucks spread out to use their lights.

3. Ball Field Lights in the Pump House
 - The committee discussed the electric and the liability pertaining to the pump house. There are Lions Club and Marysville Baseball/Softball Association members that have access to the pump house building to turn on the lights for the ball field and use the outlets for the fast pitch machine. When using the fast pitch machine the garage door is kept open. The borough's insurance agent said this would be a liability issue, especially with the chemicals being in there. After much discussion it was decided the best solution would be to have the electric service separated and the locks changed on the pump house at the pool.

4. Bingo Bash
 - The committee agreed to have Bingo Bash in January. Kim will contact local organizations to see if they would be interested in doing a bingo as a community event. Ann will check with Steve to see if we can use the Lions Club for the event.

5. Pay back money to general fund
 - The committee agreed to make the recommendation to council to have the Parks and Recreation fund pay back the general fund for the following fees: Tot-Lot engineering fees \$4,759.00, Concession Stand engineering fees- \$7,807.75 and Employee Salaries - \$4,270.05 totaling \$16,836.80.

- Kim emailed Chad Chenot to see if this is permitted. If the event is approved, the committee would like to hold the raffle on Sunday, November 4, 2012.
- The committee asked Kim to check with organizations to see if they would be interested in helping in the kitchen. Once the date is finalized Kim will contact the organization.
