Public Comment

Brian Webster, said he was representing his father James Webster of 1 South Main Street. Brian stated James is having issues with the sewer system. There is water being splashed out of his father's toilet onto the bathroom floor. The pressure from the sewer system blows the manhole cover off and sewage is running into the river. When this was questioned previously the engineer's solution was to bolt the cover down. The bolts did not hold and the manhole is still blows off. Brian stated there is a trail of toilet paper going down to the river. Scott Weaver said smoke tests were done last week and there are numerous houses that have rainwater running into the systems. Scott is sending letters to the home owners this week that need to comply. Scott said this should correct the issue.

Bryan Gleim of 309 Lincoln Street has concerns about only having two police officers. Bryan would like to see more officers hired. Bryan said the borough used to have four full time officers. Bryan states he is dealing with an issue on his street and would like to see around the clock coverage. Bryan said when there is no Marysville Police on duty and the State Police have the coverage and they are 45 minutes away.

Mayor Deborah Troutman said they are working on this. Council thanked Bryan for attending the meeting.
