A motion was made by Allen Metzger, seconded by Lance Barthel and approved unanimously to approve the consent items.

Engineering Report

Scott Weaver informed council Pennsy Supply will start paving May 12, 2014. It will take five days to mill and pave. We will need six (6) additional risers. The streets will be posted prior to paving. All cars will be towed if left parked on the street the day of paving.

A motion by Larry Little, seconded by Lance Barthel and approved unanimously to add on to paving a leveling course from Lincoln Street to Verbeke Street on Lansvale Street.

Scott said 50% of the damaged sidewalks and curbs will need to be repaired due to the milling. Wexcon Inc. will repair the storage area at Chestnut Street and Maple Avenue.

Wexcon Inc. will complete all repairs needed on the checklist.

Lance Barthel, Gary Perry, Stephen Copp, and Larry Little gave yea votes and Allen Metzger, Dave Magee and Alexandria Snyder gave nay votes. Passed with roll call vote to hire four (4) lifeguards which interviewed with Borough Manager, Scott Weaver, Kim Charles and Bonnie Hammaker.

A motion was made by Dave Magee, seconded by Larry Little and approved unanimously to close out M&T construction bond account.

A motion was made by Alexandria Snyder, seconded by Lance Barthel and approved unanimously to accept Electric Power Service (EPS) quote of \$2,690.58 to replace and add additional lighting at the sewer plant.

A motion was made by Dave Magee, seconded by Allen Metzger and approved unanimously to change the borough office hours to 7:00am to 3:00pm effective May 1, 2014.
