President Steve Copp called the council meeting to order at 7:30pm. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and Reverend Kauffman shared the invocation.

A motion was made by Allen Metzger, seconded by Dave Magee and approved unanimously to approve the May 12, 2014 minutes and the May 20, 2014 reconvene minutes. Dave Magee said he was the one nay vote at the reconvene meeting regarding Jason Myers being hired full time. Dave said the nay vote was because hiring a full time police officer was not calculated in the 2014 budget.

Engineering Report

2014 Paving Project

Scott Weaver informed council the paving project is completed. The project went over budget about \$60,000.00 because some of the roads needed to have the base replaced.

Wexcon is Scheduling Work

Scott said he met with Wexcon and more topsoil will need to be brought in to redo his yard. Ron asked when his four trees, Rose of Sharon hedges and Forsythia bushes will be replaced. Ron said we would like to have everything put back to the way it was when the project was started. Scott said he would look at the video with Ron to see what trees and shrubs need to be planted on the property. Ron said this was discussed in the fall of 2013 and it should have been taken care of by now. Ron would like this taken care of in a timely manner. Scott said it will be corrected but doesn't know when.
