400.420 – Council/Dues & Subscriptions from \$3,000.00 to \$2,500.00

410.121 – Police/Chief/Sgt. from \$61,140.00 to \$26,000.00

Mayor Troutman said there wasn't a written hiring policy for police. Ann Simonetti suggested that Mayor Troutman write a policy and have Solicitor Altland review it.
