A motion was made by Ann Simonetti, seconded by Roger Barrick and approved unanimously to agree to purchase and have installed the leaf springs for the Ford 250 from Stanley Spring's for \$1,000.00.

Borough Manager, Scott Weaver informed council we do not need to start working on the H2O match until November 2010.

Borough Manager, Scott Weaver provided council with interest rates for the 1<sup>st</sup> National Bank of Marysville, Graystone Bank and Orrstown Bank. Council recommended we transfer all monies to the 1<sup>st</sup> National Bank of Marysville. A motion was made by Ann Simonetti, seconded by Roger Barrick and approved unanimously to close out the Invest Vehicle Capital Reserve bank account and keep a \$25.00 minimal balance in the **INVEST** general, sewer and the sewer capital reserve accounts.
