President, Craig Raisner, called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance being recited and Pastor Carola Beasley – Topliffe from Bethany United Methodist Church giving the invocation. Secretary Hiddemen completed roll call of council.

**APPROVAL OF PRIOR MEETING MINUTES:**

Motion made by Ann Simonetti to approve, with two minor typographical corrections on page 4, the 01/13/2003 regular council meeting minutes was seconded by Leslie Chuhinka and passed unanimously.

**APPROVAL OF TREASURER'S REPORT**

Jill Speck presented the January 2003 Financial Statement Report. A motion made by Kathy Lebo to accept the report, was seconded by Leslie Chuhinka and passed unanimously.

It was noted on the February payable vendor list check 2792 payable to Humane Society will be reissued for \$37.50 because one animal should be billed to Rye Township and the amount due American Rock Salt Co. LLC will be reissued for \$846.44 for check 2814. A motion was made by Leslie Chuhinka seconded by Ann Simonetti to pay all bills with the preceding corrections and passed unanimously.

**CITIZENS CONCERNS:** Joan Evans, 8 Brubeck Corcle, Rye Township commented that the stray cat population has increased in their Township since Marysville enacted the Cat Licensing Program.

**PLANNING COMMISSION UPDATE** by Chairperson Stephanie Stoner. There will be a Joint Council & Planning Commission Meeting February 24, 2003 at 6:30 p.m. with a discussion on the Comprehensive Plan for Marysville's future. The Commission is reviewing the Orth-Rodgers Traffic Impact Study.

It was recommended by the Planning Commission and agreed in a motion by Ann Simonetti seconded by Kathy Lebo to appoint Art Vaitl to the Planning Commission. A motion was made by Ann Simonetti seconded by Chris Albright to appoint Shawn Vacarro to the Planning Commission as recommended by the Commission. Both appointments passed unanimously.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

**Police Report** – Chief Jake Stoss read the incident report for the month of January 2003. Refer to copy of the report.

A breakdown of the report will be given to the newspaper to inform the public of police activity monthly and a quarterly breakdown will be published in the Borough newsletter.

**Fire Company update** - Brian Webster. Refer to copy of report.

Motion was made by Ann Simonetti and seconded by Craig Raisner to dismiss the proposed **Ordinance Modifying Traffic Patterns** at 500 S. State Road because the borough cannot change a PENNDOT highway occupancy permit.

**Engineer's Report** – Refer to copy of report.

**Interceptor Update:**

Ann Simonetti will be attending a hearing on Wednesday, February 19, at the Perry County commissioner's office for a response on our CDBG grant application.

Furthermore, **PHMC** has required an archeological search prior to approving replacement of the interceptor line. Other portions of our RUS grant application are on target.

**White Tail** work has slowed due to inclement weather.

**Repair of inlets** in the Square and for Chestnut & Linden have been delayed because of inclement weather.

**Cumberland/Perry Counties Joint Task Force on Transportation** was returned to the Planning Commission with recommended amendments. Marita Kelley is a member of the Steering Committee for this project.

Review of **Proposed Amendments to the Zoning Ordinance and Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance** per recommendations by the Planning Commission was

tabled to the March meeting because Solicitor Bob Mensel was unable to attend tonight's meeting. These ordinances will be discussed at the next Planning Commission meeting.

Motion was made by Ann Simonetti to reappoint Benatec Assoc. as **Borough Engineer** was seconded by Kathy Lebo and passed unanimously.

Motion was made by Leslie Chuhinka to reappoint Robert Mensel s **Borough Solicitor** seconded by Kathy Lebo and passed unanimously. Leslie Chuhinka is to prepare a standardized review form for evaluating professional services.

The **Resolution** to open a **Marysville Lions Club Pool checking account** with First National Bank of Marysville was amended requiring two names each on the account from the Lions Club and Marysville Borough and would require one signature from each entity on checks. Bob Mensel to review verbiage of Resolution. Motion was made by Ann Simonetti seconded by Chris Albright to open the account including the amendment passed unanimously.

**Code Enforcement Report** by Janet Hardman. Refer to copy of report.

Motion made by Ann Simonetti seconded by Chris Albright to adopt the **Ordinance for Perry County COG** was passed unanimously.

Motion made by Leslie Chuhinka seconded by Kathy Lebo to adopt **Ordinance Amending the Penalties Amount for Illegal Parking** was passed unanimously.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

George Sponsler's concerns regarding **Snow Removal Parking Issues** in the Square were discussed.

A motion made by Chris Albright seconded by Ann Simonetti exonerating Mr. Palmer from the responsibility for **Unpaid Occupational/Per Capita Tax for Year 2002** and then authorize him as delinquent collector to collect these past due taxes was passed unanimously.

Mr. Palmer was congratulated on his successfully completing training and passing the Department of Community and Economic Development examination to become a **Qualified Municipal Tax Collector** for 2003 calendar year.

**PSAB Spring Conference** will be held March 16<sup>th</sup> – 18<sup>th</sup> and is open to officials interested in attending.

Motion made by Leslie Chuhinka seconded by Chris Albright to adopt the **Resolution for Access to the Safe Deposit Box Leased by the Borough of Marysville** was passed unanimously.
