

## **Parks and Recreation Meeting Minutes February 2, 2015**

### 1. Save Our Pool

#### 501 (c) (3) vs Non-Profit Organization

Kim was asked to get a quote from Dan Altland for completing the 501c3 paperwork. The committee agreed to proceed with processing the paperwork for the 501c3 for a Friends of Marysville Borough Fundraising Organization. The organization will have fundraisers to support the pool. The committee would like this put on the council agenda.

### 2. Valentine's Dinner

The Valentine's Dinner will be held on Friday, February 13, 2015 from 4:30pm – 6:00pm at the Marysville-Rye Senior Center. Pennoni Associates will sponsor the dinner. The cost is \$5.00 for adults and \$2.50 for children 12 and under. The following supplies will need to be ordered and picked up: spaghetti, meatballs, sauce, garlic butter, salad mix, croutons, cucumbers, cherry tomatoes, salad dressing, peppers and onions. The breadsticks will be replaced with Italian bread from Terranetti's.

### 3. Breakfast with the Easter Bunny

The breakfast will be held on Saturday, March 28, 2015 from 8:00am – 9:30am at the Marysville Fire House. Kim was asked to email Danielle with the Lions Club to see if she would be interested in being the Easter Bunny.

### 4. Bus Trips

There will be three NYC Bus Trips "Day on Your Own" for 2015. The dates are as follows: Saturday, May 9<sup>th</sup>, Saturday, September 19<sup>th</sup>, and Saturday, December 5<sup>th</sup>. The committee agreed to change the community day at the pool from Saturday, June 6, 2015 to Saturday, June 27<sup>th</sup> because of the softball and baseball tournaments being scheduled at the Lions Club. Community day will begin at 11:00am and the admission to the pool will be free.

8. Playground Equipment

The committee would like to place some playground equipment at the borough building. Allie asked Scott if he sent letters to the Library and Locust Village to see if they would agree to let us use some of their leased property for this. Scott said he would contact Dan Altland to write the letter. Kim mentioned to the committee the DCNR C2P2 applications are due by Thursday, April 16<sup>th</sup>. The committee agreed to put the grant information on the work session for further discussion.
