1. Codification of Ordinances and Resolutions – 71 Total – Quotes attached

Committee will make a recommendation to borough council to have the ordinances and resolutions codified by Keystone Publishers, Inc. at a price not to exceed \$1,500. Brian will check to see to how many copies this includes.

2. 2008 Municipal Domestic Animal Protective Services Agreement

Brian informed the committee that the annual fee from the Humane Society increased to \$1,253.28 to drop off animals. The committee informed Brian to contact the society to obtain the data from the past three years, and then the committee can make a more informed decision as to whether or not it wants to sign up in 2008.

3. Front Door Replacement

The committee decided that weather stripping be installed to prevent air from seeping in through the door jamb, rather than purchase a new door this year.

4. Municipal Planning Advisory Service

The committee will make a recommendation to borough council to pay the \$1,000 fee to Tri-County Regional Planning for the municipal services agreement.

5. Proposed Budget

Brian informed the committee that the proposed budget will need to be advertised and will require a motion at the upcoming council meeting. Brian informed the committee that since the borough is going to stay with a flat rate billing for sewer, the budget numbers will need to be modified to reflect the change.
