

Parks and Recreation Meeting Minutes

January 7, 2014

1. Appoint Chairperson

The committee chairperson is Gary Perry.

2. Valentine's Dinner

The dinner will be held on Friday, February 14, 2014 at the Marysville Rye Senior Center from 4:30pm – 6:00pm. The cost will be \$5.00 for adults and \$2.50 for children. Pennoni Associates will sponsor the dinner again this year. We will need people to bake cakes for the dinner as well as help. 3. Sub Sale

The committee agreed to schedule sub sales for February, March and April. The selling cost for the subs will be \$5.50 and the cost for the pretzel sandwiched will be \$4.50. Kim will notify pool members offering them the \$1.00 off their pool membership for each sub/sandwich that is sold.

4. Pool Fees for 2014

The committee agreed to raise the 2014 pool prices to the following: Family \$195.00, Individual (4-11) \$110.00, Individual (12-59) \$125.00 and Senior (60 plus) \$50.00. There will be no discount offered for memberships because of the incentive program being offered.

6. Easter Pie Sales

The pie orders are due by Wednesday, April 2, 2014 and the delivery date will be on Thursday, April 17, 2014. Kim will notify pool members offering them the \$1.00 off their pool membership for each pie that is sold.

7. New York City Bus Trips for 2014

The New York City bus trips are scheduled for the following dates: Saturday, April 26, 2014 (two buses), Saturday, September 20, 2014 (two buses) and Saturday, December 6, 2014 (two buses).
