

Parks and Recreation Meeting Minutes

July 2, 2013

1. Chance Delancey - Eagle Scout Project
 - This was tabled until August 6, 2013
2. 2013 Car Show
 - Revenue: \$2,457.75 – Expenses: \$1,650.04 = Profit for Pool: \$807.71
3. End of School Pool Party
 - Revenue: \$2,007.00 – Expenses: \$652.75 = Profit: \$1,354.25
4. Community Pool Party sponsored by the Moose
 - The committee agreed to plan the party for Sunday, August 4, 2013 or Sunday, August 11, 2013. The pool party scheduled will need to be checked for availability.
 - The committee agreed on charging \$250.00 for the daily rental.
5. Halloween Parade
 - The committee agreed to schedule the parade on Monday, October 21, 2013 with a rain date of Monday, October 28, 2013.
 - The parade will start at 6:30pm at the Masonic Lodge and end at the Bethany United Methodist Church.
6. Parks and Recreation Plan – Planning Commission Request
 - Ann said the planning commission would like to establish a parks and recreation board. This would help with applying for grants.
 - Ann asked this to be put on the council agenda for further discussion.
7. Electric Panel Box in the Pump House
 - Kim sent an invoice and statement to the Lions Club in the amount of \$540.26. No payment has been received.
 - Scott said he received an email from Phil Lehman stating the Lions Club will not pay half of the invoice for moving the electrical panel box.
