

Parks and Recreation Meeting Minutes

March 2, 2015

In attendance: Kim Charles, Steve Copp, Dave Magee, Gary Perry, Allie Snyder and Scott Weaver

1. 501 (c) (3) vs Non-Profit Organization

Dan is proceeding with the paperwork.

2. Valentine's Dinner

The total revenue was \$588.50 (\$325.00 Pennoni and \$263.50 Dinners) minus the expenses of \$319.53 and dinner at a profit of \$268.97. Kim mentioned to the committee the Mrs. Spease gave the recreation a donation of \$85.00.

3. Breakfast with the Easter Bunny

The breakfast will be on Saturday, March 28, 2015 from 8:00am – 9:30am at the Marysville Fire House. Volunteers should be there at 7:00am. Scott said we could setup everything on Friday, March 27, 2015. Danielle from the Lions Club agreed to be the Easter Bunny.

4. Save our Pool Meeting

Kim asked the committee if they would like to have the next meeting on April 6, 2015. The committee agreed with this date. Kim will send an email to everyone and let them know we have some pool fundraiser coming up and we will need help as well as picking officers for the non-profit.

5. Bus Trips

There will be two NYC Bus Trips "Day on Your Own" for 2015. The dates are as follows: Saturday, September 19th, and Saturday, December 5th. The cost for the trips will be \$60.00 per person.

6. Event Insurance

The committee agreed to have Kim get additional information on the insurance.

7. Pool

The End of School Pool Party will be held on Thursday, June 4, 2015. There will be an Ice Cream Social on Wednesday, July 8, 2015. Kim will check with the Lions Club to see when we could schedule a glow walk. Once that is scheduled we can schedule the Glow Pool Party. Kim will check with Road Hawg to see if they offer fundraising opportunities for the Hawaiian Pool Party. Kim mentioned having an Outdoor Movie at the pool. The committee agreed to have Kim get additional information and pricing. The committee agreed no outside food will be permitted at the pool if there is an event planned.

8. Car Show

The Car Show will be held on Saturday, May 16, 2015 from 9:00am – 3:00pm. Volunteers should be there at 7:00am. Kim will check with the people that attended the Save Our Pool Meetings to see if they would be available to help in the kitchen. Scott said he would talk to the Marysville Fire Police. Kim will contact Bob Richmond to get something in writing for the cost to DJ. The Boy Scouts will sell Chicken BBQ dinners. The committee agreed to have no outside food vendors.

9. Community Day at the Pool

Community day at the pool will be held Saturday, June 27, 2015 beginning at 11:00am. Admission to the pool will be free. The committee agreed there will be no outside food permitted. All food and drinks must be purchased at the concession stand.

10. Portable Restrooms

The committee agreed to have Walters Portable Toilets place an ADA Portable toilet with Hand Sanitizer Unit at a cost of \$35.00 per week for the playground and a Standard portable toilet with Hand Sanitizer Unit for the boat landing at a cost of \$20.00 per week. The portable toilets will be rented from May 1, 2015 to September 30, 2015. Gary said he would like to be notified when the portable toilets are delivered so he can show them where to place them.

11. Playground Equipment

No discussion. The committee would like to have this placed on next month's agenda.

12. Lady Finger Drop

Kim mentioned to the committee people keep asking about a Lady Finger Drop for New Year's Eve. Rob Laman talked with Kim and said he could make one. Someone would have to talk to a representative with Specialty Bakers to get their thoughts and permission to use the lady finger. The committee would like this item kept on the agenda for further discussion.

13. Public Comment

Dave Magee mentioned an Oscar Party Fundraiser. The fundraiser could include a dinner and you could sell advanced tickets for the event. The people would pick the winner and receive prizes. Gary Perry said we could try Super Bowl Party or Daytona 500 party too.
