

# **Parks and Recreation Minutes**

## **March 8, 2011**

### 1. Pool Improvements Discussion

- Roger submitted a drawing on the new concession stand and pavilion. Earl discussed what would need to be done with the plumbing.
- A building framer will be contacted to see how much it would cost to have them construct the concession stand and pavilion.

### 2. Spaghetti Dinner – Friday, February 11, 2011 – 4:30pm – 6:00pm

- Revenue – \$200.00 (from Pennoni) + \$608.85 (dinners & raffle tickets) = \$808.85
- Expenses - \$209.75 (John Gross) + \$40.85 (Giant) = \$250.60
- Profit - \$588.25

## 6. Car Show and Festival for 2011

- The committee agreed on the following fees for vendors - \$10.00 for non-profit, \$20.00 for craft/product vendors and \$25.00 for food and drink vendors
- Car registration prices - \$10.00 pre-registered by May 18, 2011 and \$12.00 day of show
- Kim will advertise for the vendors and cars show participants

## 7. Pool Concession Stand

- The Meadows
  - 3 gallon containers
    - \$50.00 for custard
    - \$40.00 for Italian ice
  - Custard - 45 – 10oz servings in each container at \$3.00 each = \$135.00 per container. Profit of \$85.00 per container
  - Italian Ice – 45 – 10oz servings in each container at \$3.00 each = \$135.00 per container. Profit of \$95.00 per container
  - Supplies the bowls or cones, spoons and scoopers
  - Kiddie Cones - \$2.00 each and small cones - \$3.00 (these are the size of Dairy Queen's large cone.)
- The committee agreed to try this at pool and see how well it sells.
