

Parks and Recreation Meeting Minutes

May 9, 2012

1. New York City Bus Trip – April 28, 2012
 - Revenue - \$4,841.00
 - Expenses - \$3,915.00 (3,340.00 bus, \$385.00 advertising & \$100.00 gratuity)
 - Profit \$926.00

2. Car Show and Festival – May 19, 2012 from 9:00am – 3:00pm
 - The Lioness will have the kitchen.
 - Kim ordered the Trophies and Dash Plaques. The total cost is \$330.95 plus shipping.
 - Kim ordered 75 t-shirts.
 - Jay Smith confirmed to be the DJ
 - Kim prepared the registration form.
 - Fire police to help park cars - Scott said he will contact John Haverstick for availability.
 - Connie, Kim, Ann & Sherree will help with the car show. Sherree will contact Steve Copp , Allen Metzger via e-mail and all Roger to see if they would help with the car show.
 - Setup for the car show:
 - Lines need to be painted on the ground for the car lineup.
 - Tent and tables need to be dropped off
 - Orange cones
 - Trash cans and have liners put in them
 - Vendor spaces need to be marked out
 - The loose blacktop needs to be cleaned up because of the motorcycles
 - The picnic tables will need to be moved
 - The grass may need to be cut

3. The committee agreed to pay back engineering fees to the general fund for the tot lot park.

4. Seasonal work to pay employee's for hours at pool and park. There was some discussion on this matter.

5. Borough's that help out with the community pool
 - Hampden Township - The Township contributes/paid bills from the general fund to the pool because it's recreation for the township.
 - Mechanicsburg Pool - The borough contributed/paid bills from the general fund to the pool and now the pool is run jointly with Upper Allen Township.
 - Camp Hill Borough Pool - They have contributed/paid bills from the general fund in the past.

6. Different rate structure for out of the borough resident's pool membership.
The committee agreed it was too late to charge different rates for out of the borough resident's this year; however we will relook at this for next year.

 - The committee recommended adding and raking mulch under the swings and slides.

 - Scott said Ken Miller will retake the Core and Right of Ways/Weeds test in May 2012. The next testing days are May 16, 2012 in Carlisle and on May 18, 2012 in Dauphin.
