In attendance were Lance Barthel, Kim Charles, Brian Harris, Nan Hiddemen, Sherree Knight and Ann Simonetti (for part of the meeting).

1. Fundraisers

Lance suggested instead of doing the small fundraisers we should look at doing an event. He suggested bringing the street fair back at the fire house. Kim will contact Brian Webster to see if the fire company would be interested in having the event with us and what they have left from previous years. Lance also suggested checking with the Lions Club to see if we can use their carnival stands.

2. Pie Sale for Easter

Kim will get the orders together on March 5, 2008 and call them in. The pickup will be on Thursday, March 20, 2008.

3. Breakfast with the Easter Bunny – Saturday, March 15, 2008

Someone paid for the multi-purpose room at Wesley United Methodist Church. Kim sent a thank you card to the church to give to the anonymous person.

Sherree found an Easter Bunny costume for us to use. We still need to find someone to wear it. Kim will ask Connie if she would be willing to wear it.

4. Central Tri-County Boroughs Association Dinner
