1. Circus

The Circus was a success and we plan on having them return in 2009.

2. Fall Festival 2008 – Saturday, September 13th

Banner – Kim will contact PennSign Company with changes to the banner proof and will fax the corrected proof to Sherree. When the changes to proof are complete Kim will order the banner and have it displayed by the Welcome to Marysville Sign across from the Rockville Diner. Once the banner is approved we can and received a quote on a new banner. The price for the banner will be \$245.00. The other banner we currently have will be re-lettered and placed at the pump station on the north end of town.

Children Activities – Kim contacted two places for Magician, Balloon Artist and Face Painting. ***Illusion Delusion*** is \$300.00 for two (2) hours and ***Magic Workshop*** has a magic show for 50 minutes at a cost of \$200.00, a Balloon Artist for two hours at a cost of \$150.00 and Face Painting for two hours at a cost of \$50.00. If we have all the events the face painting will be free. The total would be \$350.00.

The committee chose Magic Workshop and Kim will contact them to get clarification on how many hours they will actually be at the Festival.

Trophies: Kim contacted Olympia Trophy and received prices. The estimated cost of trophies not including shipping, processing etc. is \$527.75.

Kim will order the trophies so they will be here in plenty of time for the Festival.

Dash Plaques: Kim contacted Olympia Trophy and received prices. The estimated price for one hundred (100) not including shipping, processing etc. is \$150.00.

Kim will send the information to have the dash plaques processed.

Kidprint ID – Kim contacted Diana with Lower Allen Township to see if the department would be willing to bring the kidprint ID kits. She would need to check with her Chief to see if they would be able to attend and to see if there would be a charge for their staff. Kim also spoke with Carl and he said he would be help with the kidprint IDs.

Volunteers - Car show registration and voting tables will be Kim and Connie. Car parking will be Brian, Ken, Rob & Dick Messinger (will still need more volunteers for this). Announcing winners will be Brian. Vendors and Mum Sales will be Sherree. The 50/50 tickets table will be Ann.

Kettle Corn – Kim contacted him and he said he would check his availability that day.

Food Vendors - The Library will have the inside kitchen and will be serving lunch items. The Lioness will have the outside kitchen (band stand) and will be serving breakfast and lunch items. The Boy Scouts will be having a chicken BBQ. Hall's ice cream will there.

The Committee would like Kim to check on the prices for Apple Dumplings and cost of bowls.

50/50 Tickets - Kim completed the small game of chance license.

Advertising - Kim has taken care of the advertising in the Patriot News, Duncannon Record, Guide, Sentinel, Blue Ridge Cable, Comcast Cable and newsletter. Kim will be sending in information to the newspapers for block ads looking for vendors.

Mums, Pumpkins & Scarecrows - Melissa Taylor called and inquired if we would like to purchase the mums from her this year. I told her to get me a price. She is also looking into prices for making scarecrows and paint-a-pumpkins.

The committee would like Kim to call New Blooms to get a price as well.
