### 1. Rockville 5K Race

- \$1,012.00 Revenue - \$923.50 (waiting on invoice from Fry Communications) Expenses = \$88.50 Profit as of today. There was discussion on the race beginning at 8:30am next year because of the heat.

### 2. New York City Bus Trip - \$47.00 per person

- Kim will email Paula registration forms and fliers.
- Paula will see if she could get someone to donate the money for the Shriners.
- The committee asked Scott to make sure there is NO PARKING SIGNS put up along the parade route.
- Kim spoke with Paul Brandl, secretary of the Perry Lodge regarding using the building for the start of the parade and to have access to the restrooms. Paul said that should not be a problem and if I could just put something on borough letterhead so he has it for their meeting.
- The Women of the Moose said they would donate the hot dogs and rolls for after the Parade.
- Kim contacted Blair Huling to see if they would be interested in doing the line-up of the parade. Blair said he would help and we would just need to make sure we have a meeting a week before the parade.
