Lonnie asked Ann if the new COG prices are completed yet because we need to order 10 cylinders of chlorine. Ann expects to have those results by Thursday and will contact Lonnie with the price. 1. Jim Roberts of 210 Kings Highway

Jim gave a back ground of his life for the past 65 years living at the residence and who, how and when the sewer lateral was put in. Jim is concerned with what a grinder pump would amount to as electric expense and maintenance. After much discussion from everyone in the meeting, Jim's mind is now at ease with the installation of the grinder pump.

**2. Sewer Separation Project Update
(Greg Rogalski)**

Greg gave a good overview of what is left on the project. Greg said that Wexcon only has about 300 foot of sanitary sewer main to install to complete that part of the project. There is many laterals to run "Front and Lincoln Streets", Storm sewer and inlets on Front, Lincoln and Verbeke Streets. Once the temperature gets above 50 degrees Wexcon can start to do trench restoration.

3. Laundromat / amount for refuse

The committee looked at the classifications to determine what rate to charge. After some discussion the committee agreed on \$95 dollars per quarter.

4. Sludge Hauling Bid

The committee approved to place this on the council agenda to advertise.

5. 101 Valley Rate sewer/refuse (commercial)

The committee approved to charge \$45 per quarter for all commercial property that is vacant.

6. Rebecca Richards / 609 Valley Street

The committee approved to place this property on rehabilitation rate.

7. **Vacancy rate for commercial properties / what sewer and refuse rates should be used when there is no business there and we do not know what the business will be?**
The committee approved to charge \$45 per quarter for all commercial property that is vacant.
8. **Belt Filter Press Wear Guides (\$533)**
The committee approved to place this line item on the council agenda.
9. **Envirep Annual Maintenance Quote (\$1,530) + spare parts (\$1,573)**
The committee approved to place this line items on the council agenda.
