**1. Sewer Separation Project Update
(Greg Rogalski)**

Greg gave the committee a good overview of the project, he let them know that possibly by the end of this week that 97% of the pipe work will be complete. Wexcon is pulling off of our job for about a two week period, starting next week (8th April). Once they return Wexcon has the storm sewer to complete on Cameron Street and after that it's all trench restoration. The ADA crews will continue work through May to get the contracted portion completed. Greg also presented the committee with a list of change orders that need to be approved at council meeting.

2. Sludge Hauling Bid (advertising first week in April)

Scott told the committee that the advertisement will go out late this week or early next week.

3. Kings Highway Price List

Greg presented an estimate listing with two options for the replacement of the sewer line and additional work. The committee asked a few question and then approved to place this line item on the council agenda.

4. Tim Williams

Tim from Barton & Loguidice presented the committee with a slide presentation on Asset Management and how their company could help us identify risk factors for the sewer plant. The presentation was very good and pointed out a path for the replacement of equipment or at least upgrades to the existing equipment. The committee approved to look into this more and asked Scott to work with Tim and others to come up with what is best for the borough and what the cost for such a program.
