Waiting for the river to recede to install the valve and Scott will take the exhaust manifold leaks off the agenda since it's not needed anymore for cleaning.

**2. Sewer Separation Project Update**

Scott and Ron Brown gave an overview of the project and that a project meeting will be held on Thursday to review some issues. One of the biggest issues will be the fixing or replacement of Linden Avenue. Major damage occurred to the road surface during the line replacement. Ron said Linden is a mess and the paving is very shallow on a lot of the street.

**3. 6/5/12 Line blockage at Sportsmen's Club.**

Lonnie gave a report on this blockage and that USG came out to rectify the problem. While USG was here, we had them clean the main sewer line going to the pump station. There was no charge for this service.
