1. Sludge Hauling Bid (Advertised June 2013)

The sealed bid was opened at 7AM and read. There was one bidder Interstate Waste Services of PA, LLC (Advance Disposal Services). Bid prices were read for both three year and five year. The unit price stayed the same for both three and five year Sludge Hauling Bid at \$61.85 unit per ton. The committee recommends the five year Sludge Hauling Bid and to be placed on the council agenda.

**2. Sewer Separation Project Update
(Ron Brown - Engineer)**

Ron addressed the committee spelling out the project cost of 6.2M. The borough has three pots of money to pull out to cover the cost of the project. (Pennvest, H2O, Bond). The project must use all Local matches prior to using Pennvest. The paving for the project is estimated at \$270,000 dollars. Pennvest would cover \$116,000 of that cost, the remaining would be paid by local match. The issue is the scratch or leveling coat of blacktop is a moving target since you pay for the material instead of by square foot. The concern is Linden Avenue and how much it's going to take to get that road where we need it before putting the wearing course of blacktop on the street. Wexcon bid the project using Donegal to mill the streets and Pennsy Supply to pave the streets. The difference between the two for milling is four dollars per square foot. The issue might be that Donegal comes in and mills the entire town and Pennsy Supply would not come into pave for a week or two. That leaves the street torn up again for the residents. One other issue is there might not be enough funds in the project to complete the paving so the committee is recommending once they know the account amounts later on Monday to use general fund money to cover the extra cost to complete the paving.

3. Asset Management

Ann stated everything is new (piping, manholes, valves, motors and pumps) that the committee might want to take more time to look at asset management as a better path to follow. Keep line item on the agenda.

4. Interceptor Cleaning (\$12,000)

Scott talked to the manager from Duncannon (Lynn) regarding using their line cleaning trailer. Lynn is willing to allow Marysville Borough to use the line cleaning trailer. Lonnie will contact one of their men to set up the details. Steve said all local municipalities should work together.

5. Kings Highway

Scott stated Wexcon should be back to complete the work once the ground dries out towards the end of summer.

6. Fred Essis vacant properties

Scott presented a letter prepared by Dan Altland regarding Mr. Essis vacant properties. The committee requested Scott mail the letter to Mr. Essis.

7. Risers for the paving (\$7,684.50)

The committee recommends the Risers for paving be placed on the council agenda.

8. ADA Ramp Williams and 11&15

The committee requested Scott to find out if it's possible to cut an opening in the curb to allow handicapped residents to use instead of going around the curb and possibly into traffic.

9. Home Lateral's (ordinance 18-319)

Ann recommends amending the verbiage to reflect what other municipalities use as a standard. Scott is to follow up with Dan to see if this can be completed for the council meeting Monday evening.
