Lonnie gave a report that the Tideflex Valve has been installed and that that completed the outstanding issues.

**1. Sewer Separation Project Update**

Greg Rogalski and Ron Brown gave the committee and others a very good overview of the project and where we need to be before the October 15<sup>th</sup> cut off point for base repair. The subway will be milled and paved the week of August 20, prior to the start of school. While the milling machine is in the borough they are asking council to approve a \$30,000 dollar mill and repair of Linden Avenue. Many questions from all in attendance and Greg and Ron did a good job of answering those.

**2. 300 Block Kings Highway Pipe Damaged**

Greg Rogalski has prepared a preliminary cost for the repair of this pipe. Greg used the figures from the contractor (Wexcon) that is doing the sewer separation. Total cost estimate for the replacement and other costs is \$42,265.00

**3. Easement Clearing**

There was much discussion on the easements and how to clear them so we can maintain the sewer system. Ann volunteered to send an email to the COG members to see if we can borrow a brush hog to open up the easements.

**4. Cleveland Brothers – Generator Parts Replacement**

Lonnie explained that after the year PM was completed by Cleveland Brothers they gave us a list of three items that should be corrected and a quote for the parts and labor to complete the repairs. Total cost would be with parts and labor is \$1,380.00. The committee recommended to have the work completed and to place this line item on the council agenda.
