MINUTES

1. Rockville Diner (see attached e-mail/statement)

Committee agreed to have Brian proceed with filing with the Sheriff for the Marysville Diner and also for Frank Skirpan. The filing fee is \$48.41 for the Prothonotary and \$300 for the Sheriff's Department.

2. Sigma Flowmeter

Committee recommended Brian contact DEP to determine if the flow meters need to be down-loaded now that the borough has been removed from the corrective action plan. In addition, the committee recommended that we repair the flow meter at a cost of \$2,200.

3. Consumption Based Billing

Brian presented the committee with a sample using consumption based billing for the month of July. The sample was based on the same rates that Duncannon Borough charges their residence. The committee indicated that we pursue consumption based billing and that we also change to monthly billing versus quarterly effective January 1, 2008. Connie will also assimilate a consumption based report for a winter month to determine how the seasons will affect consumption.

4. Trout Run

Ann announced that she was successful in getting \$53,000 from the Perry County Growing Greener funding designated for this project. Ryan Rhoades was present from Pennoni to discuss the Trout Run project. Ann explained the funding situation and the committee discussed other alternatives to reduce the costs. Ann will contact Dan Altland to determine if he would be willing to contribute to the project or he would be willing to possibly relocate the mobile home so gabions can be installed on the south side.

5. Downtown Revitalization

Separation of the sanitary and storm sewer was discussed on the square prior to completion of the revitalization project. Ann explained possible grant application that may enable the borough to obtain funds for the separation

6. Jet-Vac

Brian explained to the committee that Jet-Vac has not flushed the system lately and that the rate is \$210 per hour. The committee indicated to specify the important areas and spend 2 days this year flushing the system and the remainder next budget year.

7. Mobile Home Flow Meter

Brian asked whether the committee would like to see the flow meter reinstalled at the mobile home park since it has not been operational for many years. The committee indicated that it would not be replaced.
