MINUTES

1. Billing

The committee agreed that an additional bill in May with a letter stating the reason for the billing is appropriate. By doing this, the billing cycle will then be on a calendar quarter and the next bill will be sent out July 1st. In the letter, Brian will explain that residents have the option to set up monthly payments rather than quarterly payments if they wish.

2. Senior Citizen Discount

Brian informed the committee that he has had numerous calls recently regarding the flat rate billing for sewer. Brian will let the residents know that we are exploring possibilities at this point.

3. 518 Landsvale Street

Committee recommended Jeff Black to come out and dig the lateral that was installed by Ben Smith at the adjacent property to determine if Ben Smith inadvertently may have tied into or crushed the lateral from 518 Landsvale. Once the trench is exposed, the committee will determine the next step.

4. Dan Stephens

Committee agreed to reduce Dan Stephens refuse bill from commercial to residential contingent upon Dan submitting a letter stating that he no longer operates a business. Ann stated that the reduced rate would not affect the status of being able to operate a business in the future. Brian will call Dan and request a letter.

5. Trash RFP

Brian informed the committee that the trash hauling contract expires in August and that he will be asking council to make a motion to put out a request for proposal.
