1. Curb and Storm Inlet Repair

No action due to weather, but there was comments about the ADA landing pads are not sealed and that water is getting underneath. This will be added to the list to be fixed once the weather warms up.

2. Ordinance 21-206 Sidewalk and Curb

Scott is to provide the Ordinance for next month's meeting.

3. Paving Plan 2014

Pennoni Engineering prepared by street the bid specks and estimated costs. The committee after looking at the information made the decision to try to complete the north end of the borough, so at least one part of the borough street would be completely paved. The streets they would like to see completed this years are as follows:

After much discussion the committee would like to use \$150,000 out of Liquid Fuels and the remainder would come out of Capital Reserve. The committee approved to have this line item on the council agenda.

Pennoni also prepared a Preliminary Schedule and Scott presented this as well.

4. US11&15 Improvement Package 11-7 / 11-A

Scott presented a couple packets of information. The one packet was from the past Task Force Meeting held January 30th. This was the meeting minutes from the meeting. The second packet was set changes that were listed from 6 to 8 years ago. Most of the item listed were complete. The one item listed was to make most of our streets that enter onto 11&15 one way. The committee does not want to make the streets one way and ask Scott to have them taken off the list.
