**1. Review Crews Timesheets**

**2. Review Equipment logs (travel)**

Corrected on math error on the third page of the F250 (116001 should be 117001)

**3. Review Chapter 15 (motor vehicles and traffic) Part 4 & 5.**

Steve asked Scott to get him a copy of what has been worked on so the committee can move forward. Scott mentioned that this line item may need worked on other day rather than the committee meeting days.

**4. Pot hole and sink whole repair (on going)**

There was much discussion about the area of Ridge View Drive and how the road is so bad that the cold patch is not staying in the holes. Ann made a comment about a system the state uses and that we may be able to pay them to come in to repair these areas. The consensus was to wait and bore down the road and replace the road back to proper specks.

**5. ADA curb cuts (roughly \$395,000)**

Ron Brown from Pennoni Assos. Address the committee about the ADA Act and has a copy of a court decision saying that if we were to move forward with the paving of the streets the way it's spelled out in the contract of the North Phase of the sewer separation we would have to install ADA curb cuts and an estimated fifty intersections. Rough estimate from Scott, Bernie Kuhn, and Ron Brown were all in the same area. Ron Brown is to get Scott a better estimate for the CDBG grant application.

**6. Clothing Allowance**

**(\$300 to cover two pair of boots and jeans)**

The committee approved to take to council that the Borough would give an allowance for boots

**7. Ordering the new street signs (grant)**

Ken reported that there are only a couple signs to come in yet and that this week East Penn Township will be sending up one man and there bucket truck to install the signs on Valley Street and State Road. Steve asked what the charge was for the truck and manpower. Ken replied that Mr. Polly is not charging anything for there service and that, we have an open relationship with them for getting thing done. It's the way municipalities should work together.

**8. 234 Park Dr. Water not draining off road (icing)**

After much discussion the committee asked that the maintenance men try and open the pipe to relieve the issue.

**9. Listing of all Motorized Vehicle/Tools**

Steve and Allen would like to take more time and go over the list. They asked to have a walk through tour of the maintenance area and to go over the list while inspecting the items on the list. The walk through tour will be Friday 9, 2012 at 7:30AM. The committee asked that Ken, Rob and Scott attend.

Ken Miller asked if they should street sweep in the north end of town while the construction is going on. We will have to communicate this with the police department.
