**1. Review Crews Timesheets**

Allen Metzger only comment was Scott signs his own time sheet. Allen suggested that someone else should sign Scott time sheet.

**2. Review Equipment logs (travel)**

**3. Review Chapter 15 (motor vehicles and traffic) Part 4 & 5.**

Steve Copp and Allen Metzger moved to table this until Roger Barrick can attend to work on this together. Scott said that it would be good if all four of them took the borough car and drove the streets after the changes were made to the ordinance.

**4. Pot hole and sink whole repair (on going)**

Steve Copp said there is a sink whole at the end of Lansvale street that needs filled. Ann Simonetti told the committee that there is a pot hole on Pine street at the stop sign at Maple Ave. The road crew said they would take care of them. They are running for more cold patch today to fill those and other issues.

**5. ADA curb cuts (roughly \$175,000) CDBG Grant**

Scott informed the committee that the grant was submitted. Scott also informed the committee that if we do not get the grant and still want to move forward with the ADA curb cuts we could be like other municipalities and make the home owner install the curb cuts. Ken Miller said Mechanicsburg Borough put the home owners as the responsible party to install the cuts, but would try to help out with grants and if no grant money they would pay for curb cuts and place a lien on the home owner and let them make payments to the borough. Scott is to find out who owns the curbs, the borough or the home owner.

**6. 600 Block of Susquehanna Street**

Sherree Knight asked to have this on the agenda so the committee and Maintenance Men know that the people in that area were complaining that

they were not getting the service the rest of the tax payer were for street cleaning and leaf picking. Ken Miller filled in the past couple of year on what had taken place and that they are now getting as much service as the rest of the town. But warned be careful what you ask for when the snow flies and cars are parked on the street.

**7. Ordering the new street signs (grant)**

Some discussion from everyone in attendance, the remarks were all positive and the crew is doing a great job. Ann Simonetti asked if we know what the life expectancy was on the overlaid signs versus new signs? Ken Miller will check and report back.

**8. Vehicle Management Report  
(Instead of Equipment Logs)**

After much discussion about a new gas/inspection log, the committee asked Scott to place a remarks section on the bottom of the page. The committee then instructed Scott to have this on the agenda for council meeting.
