1. Lansvale Street

Scott presented the committee with a letter from PC Construction detailing the time frame for the repairs to the street from the running of large trucks.

2. Long Term Planning for Paving Streets

The committee had a long discussion about the paving of streets with much disagreement on the way to proceed. The streets that are in question are Catherine, Elizabeth, Jacob, Mill, Weaver, Center, Ridgeview and Park. This line item will remain on the agenda for further discussion. The committee asked Scott to look at what the payments would be for a 1.2 million dollar loan for ten and fifteen years.

3. Slurry Seal

Scott reported that he had sent out a reply from Greg Rogalski on what the Slurry Seal was and what it was good for. The committee agreed that it's not a process they wanted to do.

4. Post Office Blurb for News Letter/ Paint Curbs Both Sides

Scott will come up with a blurb to put in the next newsletter. There was much discussion about this area and how to solve the issue of people changing lanes to deposit mail in the box next to the street. Stopping or parking in the middle of the street to walk into the post office or to deposit mail in the box. Scott reported that he had received a complaint about office. Scott asked to paint the curb along that portion of the street yellow for a better visual aid. The committee agreed to paint the curb. The committee asked Scott Weaver to contact Solicitor Dan Altland about placing a safety rail along the curb in front of the post office. To hinder people from using the drop box in front of the post office.

5. Drainage at Rockville Bridge/South Main Street

Scott reported about the issue with standing at the Rockville Bridge. We are looking into replacing the pipe but it is under the bridge and Scott thinks that Norfolk Southern might have an issue with it. We will continue to research the issue until we can fix it.
