Dave Magee asked who pays for the advertisement? Ann replied that the Borough pays for it. Lance had a comment about the width of the road and the restriction from parking on both sides of the road. Lance said that there wouldn't be enough room for a large vehicle to get through with cars parked on both sides. Ken Miller said we could never get a plow truck through there as well.
