1. Bid Opening for Cub Cadet

The borough received one bid for the cub cadet tractor. The committee agreed to place this on the.

2. Review Equipment logs (travel)

There was discussion on the weight classification for the F550 trucks. The weight class for the F550 trucks must be inspected twice a year. If the weight was lowered by 500 lbs. the trucks would only need inspected once a year. The committee agreed to place this on the work session agenda.

3. Skid Steer No Flat Tire (\$180 per tire)

The no flat tire is a rubber compound that does not allow the tire to go flat. There was discussion on how much it would cost to fix the flat tire verses spending \$720.00 to have them filled with the rubber compound. The last tire repair cost the borough \$20.95. The committee agreed to place this on the work session agenda.

4. Correct Issue on Cassel Street (11 & 15 to Verbeke Street)

Ken suggested asking East Penn Twp. to have them use their paver and our staff would help them do the work. Allen stated to have the road milled down would even be an improvement. Ken is going to check with East Pennsboro Township. Scott will see if we can get this milled the same time the milling machine is in the borough for the sewer project.

5. Traffic Signal Permit Revision (no turn on red)

Ron Brown stated that we received notice the state has the borough's request and we should hear back from them within four to six weeks.

6. Ordinance 21-206 Sidewalk and Curb

Scott was asked to call Mechanicsburg Borough to find out how the payment structure was set up for the residents that needed to replace the curb and sidewalk. Scott said the ordinance will be in the next quarterly mailer.

Ken reported that the guys have cleaned up the area of the steps leading from 11&15 to the subway and fixed the broken concrete steps. They are keeping up on the mowing and maintenance issues.

Lance brought up the issue of weeds and grass between the road and curb. Ken said they will take care of it the next day.

The committee asked to place a line item for the work session to discuss who oversees the subcontractors while they do work in the borough.

This discussion came up in street committee about the nutrient credits from the sewer plant. The committee would like this line item on the work shop as well.
