1. Paving for Eastern Part of Borough

After very much of a discussion the committee approved to move to the Finance Committee and then onto council agenda

2. Long Term Planning for Paving Streets

The committee covered this line item on the #1 discussion. The committee is looking at getting residence to repair or replace curb and sidewalk that are in disrepair before the borough would consider paving the streets.

3. Rock Wall

The committee approved to place this line item on both the Finance Committee and Council agenda's.

4. Speed Bumps South Main during Construction

The committee discussed that the speed bumps would only be used for the Rock Slope Project. Then use them in other parts of the borough if needed in future projects.

**5. Change Street to One Way for Rock Slope Project
(1st block of Lincoln and Valley Street Ext.)**

After much discussion the committee asked to have this line item placed on the council work shop for further discussion. The committee would like to see Lincoln Street be one way from Valley to Front Street be permanent. Also make Cameron Street one way east from Verbeke to South State and to remove parking from South State Street

The last move that was not agreed on was Valley Street Ext one way out from Verbeke to Valley. The committee was split on making this one a permanent but agreed to it for the Rock Slope Project.
