**1. Review Equipment logs (travel)**

Some discussion but no issues

**2. New Truck before Winter**

Committee recommended placing this line item on the finance committee's agenda.

**3. Review Chapter 15 (motor vehicles and traffic) Part 4 & 5.**

Scott handed out the entire chapter to the committee and after some discussion it was agreed that the committee would look over the chapter and send Scott any recommended changes. The committee also recommended placing this on the council agenda.

**4. ARLE grant submitted**

Scott reported that he has submitted the application but has not received a reply.

**5. Bridge Review (South Main Street)**

Scott reported that the men cleared an easement for the sewer main and that we can use this as an access to the bridge, if needed.

**6. Removal of the speed humps on Kings Highway**

Allen brought to the committee that he would like to see the humps removed since they are not doing what they were designed to do and that they are flattening. Allen thought that since the milling machine would be in town for the sewer project that we could have them mill the humps off. After much discussion, an email response from Ron Brown was presented showing the one speed hump is improper due to the 360' rule. Also, stop signs should be posted at Kings Highway and Antler Drive per the ordinance. Scott is to look at the ordinance for accuracy and he will have the maintenance crew correct the items and install the proper signs and stop bars.

**7. List of Equipment/Repairs for Budget (mower)**

Ken presented a list of items that can be done this year and some next year. One issue is the future of the F450/ After some discussion, it was decided that the truck should not be repaired. Ken asked if it would be okay to switch the tires from the F450 to the F550. Ken also asked to take the electronic devices for the salt spreader off the F450 and put them on the F550. Scott said to make sure that there is not a warranty before they start tearing thing apart.

Ken also asked to purchase new tires for the F250 before the winter and plowing starts. Committee recommended to place this on the finance agenda.

Ken also brought up the line painting since the subway has been completed and paved. A center line is needed immediately for the safety of vehicular traffic. Ken had a handout of all the streets that need line painting. We have 15,027 feet of center line yellow and 1,625 feet of white line. Scott shared line painting has been bid thru the COG.
