Minutes

1. Joyce Hoffman – Request to have a handicap sign installed in front of her house.

Committee recommended Brian prepare a letter to Joyce stating that no handicap sign will be installed since she does not own a car and actively drive. The borough does not want to set precedent regarding this and each circumstance needs to be reviewed individually.

2. Roy Allandar – Request to have the top of Locust Street paved.

Committee recommended Brian draft a letter to Roy stating that the borough is delaying paving the remainder of Locust Street until Wesley Church extends the sewer and connects to the main on Linden, since the street will need to be cut.

Committee also discussed the condition of Maple Street and discussed possible paving projects that could be completed by using liquid fuels money and utilizing the Pennsylvania Infrastructure Bank low interest loans to fund the project.

3. Margaret Singer – Various requests

Committee recommended that Brian draft a letter to Mrs. Singer stating that Linden Street will not be paved beyond Sylvan Street and that the borough will not be removing trees surrounding her property. The Borough of Marysville will maintain the drainage swale at the eastern end of her property.

4. Square – requested to eliminate over night parking

Committee recommended enforcing 4 hour parking only between the hours of 6:00am and 10:00pm. The 4 hour parking will be eliminated the weekend of April 13-15 due to a pool tournament being held at the Moose. Both of these items will be put on the council agenda for action.
