1. 200 Kings Highway

Committee agreed that the storm water flow that discharges at the rear of Fred Horanic's property is not the borough's responsibility. Ann also indicated that this was extensively looked into in the past and the borough was not responsible for any improvements.

2. Kings Highway Storm Sewer Extension

Jeff black indicated that the proposed storm sewer extension along Kings Highway would be costly and not likely to rectify the flow problem. Jeff indicated that installing shallow perforated pipe would be the most cost effective. Committee recommended Brian speaks with Roger regarding this option.

3. Bittings Alley
